HOMEGROUP & PERSONAL STUDY QUESTIONS

Scripture: Hebrews 12:1-3

1. When you consider the crowd (or cloud) of Christian witnesses in your life, from whom do you draw inspiration from. Can you provide examples for why this (or these) witnesses inspire you?
2. Hebrews chapter eleven is sometimes called the Heroes of the Faith Hall of Fame. Which of these listed examples are great inspiration to you? Why? Which of these examples are surprises to you? Why?
3. The Heroes of Faith chapter also lists a number of named and unnamed heroes (Heb. 11:32-40). How do these witnesses inspire or surprise you? What do you learn from their inclusion in this account?
4. In Hebrews 12:1-2 we are encouraged to “strip off every weight that slows us down, especially sin...” The author implies there are things that can slow our spiritual journey and maturity that are not sin. What might be slowing you down that is not necessarily sin?
5. The answer to stripping off the things that slow us or trip us lies in “keeping our eyes on Jesus” (Hebrews 12:2). What does this mean to you? How do you keep your eyes on Jesus? Can you provide specific examples?
