Policy Highlights

- 2022 - Iowa expands options for turkey hunters by passing SF 2334, which allows for the use of .410 bore and 28-gauge shotguns.
- 2019 - Iowa hunting and fishing license will include anatomical donor designation following the passage of SB 86.
- CSF continues to work with legislators in attempts to add a constitutional amendment affirming Iowans right to hunt and fish.
