Policy Highlights

- **2023** – Passed a bill creating a discounted lifetime combination hunting and fishing license for youth under the age of 10.
- **2023** – Passed legislation creating liability standards for private landowners using prescribed fire, on of the most efficient and effective wildlife habitat management practices in Arkansas' ecosystems.
- **2021** – Passed a bill that allows for hunter education to be taught in the Arkansas public school system.
