The Hawaii Legislative Outdoor Heritage Caucus was established in December of 2022 under the leadership of Senator Lorraine Inouye and former Senator Gil Keith Agaran. With the addition of the Hawaii Outdoor Heritage Caucus, all 50 states are now represented in the National Assembly of Sportsmen's Caucuses network. Since its inception, the Caucus has hosted several events, including the inaugural kick-off reception and a policy luncheon during the 2023 legislative session.

Policy Highlights

- In 2024, Hawaii Caucus Leaders are focusing on water access and invasive species prevention in response to the wildfires that devastated Maui in 2023.
- In 2023 the Hawaii Legislative Outdoor Heritage Caucus hosted their first official policy luncheon to share information about sportsmen's interests with state legislators.
- In December 2022, the Hawaii Legislative Outdoor Heritage Caucus officially joined the NASC Network as the 50th and final state to create their own Caucus dedicated to protecting and advancing our time-honored outdoor traditions.
