Policy Highlights

- SB 18-143 Future Generations Act included provisions that will grow the number of hunters and anglers, expand public and private land access, increase big game populations, improve wildlife populations and increase the number of fish stocked throughout Colorado.
- SB 19-1026 Updated fines associated with wildlife law violations to serve as an effective deterrent against poaching and other wildlife crimes.
- SB22-031 Mountain lion and bobcat hunting ban was defeated in Committee with a 4-1 vote
