

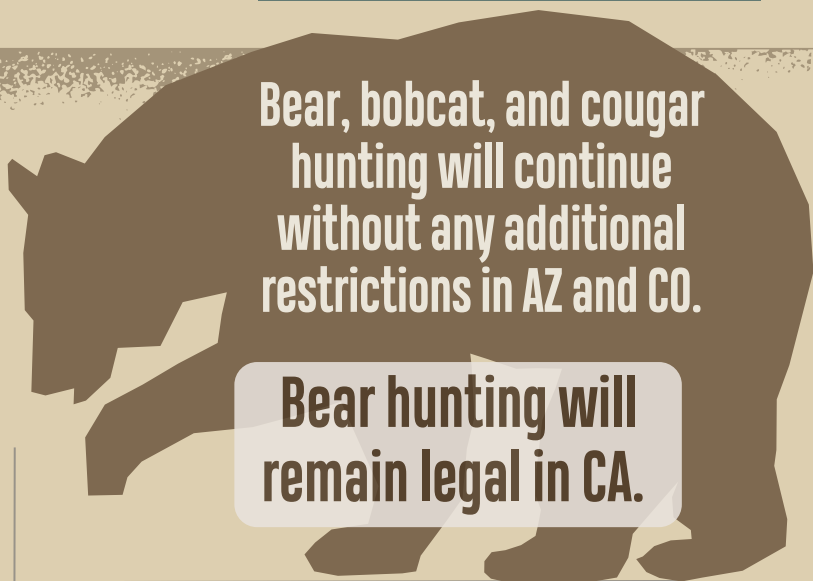

Bear, bobcat, and cougar hunting will continue without any additional restrictions in AZ and CO.

Bear hunting will remain legal in CA.

Boating and fishing access areas will benefit from enhanced funding from canoes and kayakers in NH.



Hunters will gain the ability to protect their hearing while afield by using firearm suppressors in VT.



HUNTERS AND TRAPPERS

will retain the ability to pursue mountain lions in TX.

Upland sporting dog traditions will continue without restriction in NH.



Sporting dog owners in GA, KY, MA, and TN will not be subject to unwarranted kennel and tethering restrictions.

Traditional dog training methods will continue in CA.

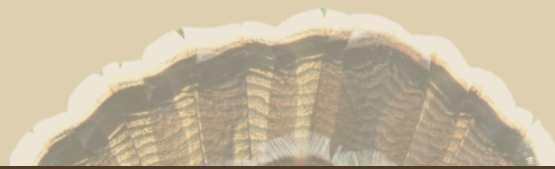


Air guns (UT) and air bows (OK) are now lawful methods of take and contribute to conservation funding.

The Gould's turkey has been recommended for delisting by the Game and Fish Commission in NM.



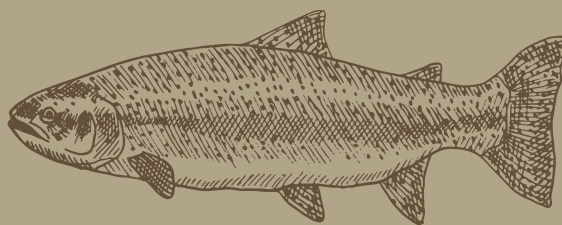
Modern Sporting Rifles will not be banned in OR.

Firearm owners will not be required to purchase firearm liability insurance in CA.

Snare and/or leghold traps will continue to be legal in VA and VT.
