Policy Highlights

- In 2021, GSC Member Governor Greg Gianforte enacted HB 647 reducing financial barriers to hunter and angler recruitment efforts of non-resident college students.
- In 2017, SB 218 amended the law to increase the age limit to anyone 10 or older to hunt for up to two years without completing a hunter education course.
- In 2015, former GSC Member Governor Steve Bullock enacted HB 250 which clarified the legality of using suppressors for hunting in the state.
