Policy Highlights

- **2023 SB 1057** - After failing to advance out of committee, the bill would have provided additional protections to the Alpine Wild Horse Herd, further limiting conservation and population management efforts.
- **2019 H 2433** - Amends the Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to Game and Fish regarding current definitions and removes the word "trophy" and respective definition from the language.
- **2018 H 2342** - Provides that monies received from vehicle user fees and other permits shall be deposited into the Game and Fish Fund and be used for the administration of the Off-Highway Vehicle User Indicia Program.
