In 2009, the Congressional Sportsmen's Foundation (CSF) formed the Governors Sportsmen's Caucus (GSC), a bipartisan caucus of governors with the mission to protect and advance the interests of America's sportsmen and women, and advance professional fish and wildlife management policy.

The GSC facilitates communication and information exchange between participating offices in support of policies and regulations that promote and advance hunting, angling, recreational shooting and trapping. Guided by a bipartisan leadership team of governors and staffed through CSF, the GSC complements and enhances the Congressional Sportsmen's Caucus and the National Assembly of Sportsmen's Caucuses. Presently, the bipartisan GSC consists of 29 members, representing diverse regions of the nation.
