



## DIAGNOSTIC TEST

### Spellodrome Diagnostic Test

The Diagnostic Test is used to determine the strengths and weakness of individual student's spelling skills. The results can be used to select the spelling lists for inclusion in a class, group or individual spelling programme.

#### Administration

The Diagnostic Test is available for each year level - Reception through to Year 6.

#### Reception

The Reception Diagnostic test is divided into two parts – A and B.

**Part A** would be administered after the students have completed the first 20 lists of the Spellodrome Reception Course.

**Part B** would be administered after the Reception Programme has been completed.

#### Year 1 – Year 6

Students complete the Diagnostic Test at the beginning and end of the school year. The initial test will highlight individual and class strengths and weaknesses. The final assessment will measure progress and determine future areas of need.

The spelling skills and strategies assessed in the Diagnostic Test are aligned to the Statutory Requirements for each year Level and the Spelling Courses available in Spellodrome.
