Installation Notes

Due to an incompatibility issue between Ecollect Subscription Manager and newer versions of PowerSchool, all customers are asked to contact Support directly for upgrade assistance. Please open a Support Case in [PowerSchool Community](#) to initiate the upgrade process.

NOTES:

- PowerSchool version 12.0/19.0 or higher is required for ECO_20.1.0.0. Users on lower versions of PowerSchool will need to update to version ECO_20.1.0.0_PS11 of Ecollect Forms.
- **Subscription Manager must be upgraded to ESM_19.12.0.0 prior to installing Ecollect.** The updated Subscription Manager plugin can be downloaded here: [Subscription Manager](#)
Note: Prior version of subscription manager will no longer permit Ecollect updates. ESM_19.12.0.0 is required.
- It is recommended that the installation of Ecollect coincide as closely as possible with a system restart. **Ecollect functionality will be impaired between the installation of Ecollect and the PowerSchool application restart.**

Feature:	Description:
Parent/Family SSO	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• With Single Sign-On (SSO), parents can now upload documents within forms without needing to create or sign into a separate account. If SSO is enabled, when a parent or student opens a form in the PowerSchool Student and Parent portal, they will be automatically authenticated and can seamlessly interact with document attachment fields.

Resolved Issues/Bug Fixes

Issue:	Description:
Parent – Multiple Choice Element	As a parent completing a form, if a multiple-choice element only has one option, the choice is always selected. This issue is now resolved.
Admin - Saving Enrollment Configuration	When configuring Enrollment, if the email entered for the District Administrative user is exceeds 50 characters, an error appears, which prevents saving the configuration. This issue is now resolved.
