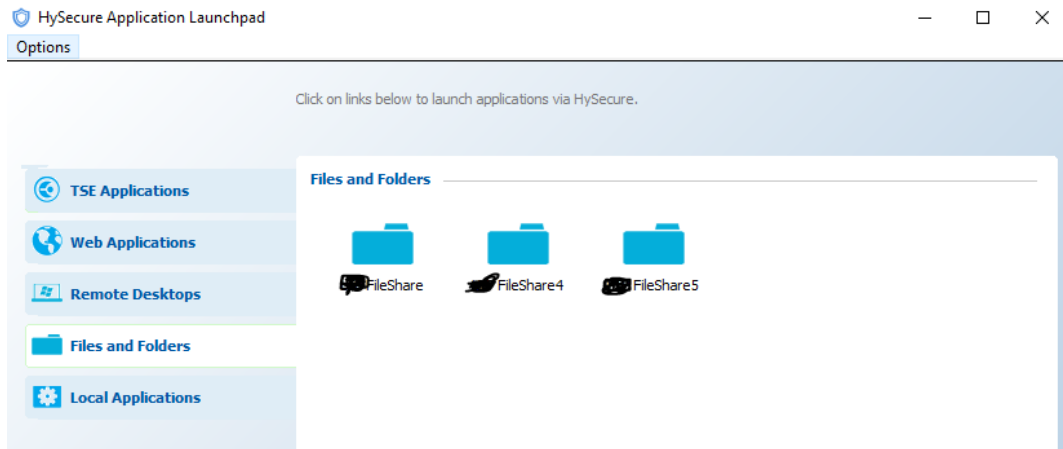


## Document to configure Microsoft Fileshare through HySecure VPN



1. Once the Microsoft fileshare access was provided, the client machine makes connections to IPC\$ folder of file server with anonymous user id.

As the session with file server is already established with anonymous user id and hence when we are trying to access the other folders of File server, it is connecting with anonymous id and gives error that "you don't have the permission to access the folder".

To delete that saved credentials with anonymous user id we must first run the below command:

```
# net use * /delete
```

**NOTE:** This will delete all the mapped drive to the machine.

- Now check the two fields in “User Options” as shown below, this is modifying the Fileshare access application in HySecure Management Console:

This is done so that when the connection to the Shared Drive is made the user credentials will be saved instead of anonymous user id and credentials.
