New Feature: Organisation Managers and Admins can manage or remove invitations to their organisations and positions (share links).

Enhancement: Spacing of tables has been improved throughout the site.

Enhancement: Improvements have been made to the pagination of data tables.

Bug Fix: An issue with inactive positions appearing in a supplier's allocated positions list has been fixed.

Bug Fix: A UI issue was fixed where an obsolete separator was being displayed when there was no action after it. The issue was present when there is no option to allocate a position.

Bug Fix: An issue with the user's mobile phone number not getting imported automatically in the standard police check has been fixed.
