

How to install the license file for Microsoft Business Solutions - Navision

INTRODUCTION

This article discusses how to install the license file for Microsoft Business Solutions - Navision.

MORE INFORMATION

When you receive a new license file from Microsoft Business Solutions, you must install the license file on the following:

- The server that is running Navision
- The computer that is running Microsoft SQL Server
- The client computers that are running Navision

Install the license file on the server that is running Navision

To install the license file, follow these steps:

1. Copy the license file to the following folder:
Drive:\Program Files\Microsoft Business Solutions-Navision\Database Server
2. Restart the Navision service so that the license change can take effect. To do this, follow these steps:
 - a. Click **Start**, point to **All Programs**, point to **Administrative Tools**, and then click **Services**.
 - b. In the Services Microsoft Management Console (MMC) snap-in, right-click **Microsoft Business Solutions-Navision Database Server *ServerName***, and then click **Restart**.

Note *ServerName* is a placeholder for the name of the Navision server.

Install the license file on a computer that is running SQL Server

You can use the **Upload** function in Navision to install the license file. To do this, follow these steps:

1. Click **Start**, point to **All Programs**, click **Microsoft Business Solutions-Navision**, and then click **Microsoft SQL Server Option for Microsoft Business Solutions-Navision**.
2. On the **Tools** menu, click **License Information**.
3. Click **Upload**.
4. In the **Upload License File** dialog box, locate and then select the license file that you want to import.
5. Click **Open**.

The **Upload** function uploads the license file to the server or to the database, depending on the license option that you chose when you created the database.

Install the license file on each Navision client

You can use the **Import** function to install the license file. To do this, follow these steps:

1. Click **Start**, point to **All Programs**, point to **Microsoft Business Solutions-Navision**, and then click **Microsoft Business Solutions-Navision**.
2. On the **Tools** menu, click **License Information**.
3. Click **Import**.
4. In the **Import License File** dialog box, locate and then select the license file that you want to import.
5. Click **Open**.

The **Import** function copies the license file to the following folder:
C:\Program Files\Microsoft Business Solutions-Navision\Client
