Accessing the AURIN Portal via the AAF

Overview

This is a guide for non-university users to access the AURIN portal with an AAF Virtual Home (VH) login.



When logging in to AURIN Portal, you will be asked to select your institution from the AAF list. Select AAF Virtual Home from the drop down list as shown below.
