Element 3.6 Gender response wording changes	Wording changes to some responses: Trans Female (MTF or Male to Female) Trans Male (FTM or Female to Male) Gender Non-Conforming (i.e. not exclusively male or female)
Element 3.12 Destination wording changes and new response option	Was: Permanent housing for formerly homeless persons (such as: CoC project; or HUD legacy programs; or HOPWA PH) Now: Permanent housing (other than RRH) for formerly homeless persons New: Rental by client, with RRH or equivalent subsidy
Element 3.20 Housing Move-in Date - now used for all permanent housing projects.	Project Start Date is the the date following application that the client was admitted into the project.
Element 3.917 Living Situation - wording changes	<i>From Permanent housing for formerly homeless persons (such as: a CoC Project) to Permanent housing (other than RRH) for formerly homeless persons. From Rental by client, with other ongoing housing subsidy to Rental by client, with other housing subsidy (including RRH)</i>
4.2 Income and Sources - Social Security Disability Insurance	Changed to Insurance not Income.
4.3 Non-Cash Benefits	Removed Section 8, public housing or rental assistance and removed Temporary rental assistance.
Elements 4.5 Physical Disability, 4.6 Developmental Disability, 4.7 Chronic Health Condition, 4.8 HIV/AIDS, 4.9 Mental Health Problem, 4.10 Substance Abuse	Removed dependent elements: Documentation of disability and severity on file, and "Currently receiving services/treatment for this disability?".
Element 4.12 Contact: Field 2 and	Responses changed from "location of contact" to "staying on streets, ES, or SH"

R2 RHY - BCP Status:	Wording change - <i>FYSB Youth now Youth Eligible for RHY services</i>
R13 Family Critical Issues -	To decrease data collection burden, the responses have been streamlined. The previous responses will <i>not</i> be mapped to the new responses.
R14 RHY Service Connections -	Data collection has been reduced. The 2015 V5 response option number remain and indicate data previously collected under that response option should remain associated with those numbers, but wording of the response should be updated to reflect the response
R15 Commercial Sexual Exploitation/Trafficking, R16 Labor Expotation/Trafficking	Collection Point changed from Project Start to Project Exit
R17 Project Completion Status -	Response options were streamlined.
R18 Counseling - NEW	New element, collected at Project Exit.
R19 Safe and Appropriate Exit	New element, collected at Project Exit.
R20 Aftercare plans -	Projects will now be required to conduct/record Post Exit Follow-up.

V7 SSVF VAMC Station Number	Converting from a text field to a drop down list to ensure accuracy
V8 HUD-VASH Voucher Tracking - NEW	Service list indicating status of voucher and how it is to be administrered. (11 values in pick list)
V9 HUD-VASH Exit Information - NEW	New Case Management Exit Reason field added to the exit screen
P4 Connection with SOAR	Now required for SSVF.
