



MyAgData® and the Cloud

An increasing number of agricultural industry organizations are offering their own proprietary cloud data storage solutions to make it easier to access your data and to enable increased collaboration.

Your as-applied planting data stored in an equipment manufacturer or third-party cloud can be pulled and used for your acreage report.

Here's how to connect Climate FieldView Plus to MyAgData.

1. In the Cloud Connect section of the Precision Ag Data page, select **FieldView Plus** from the list.

2. Click **Connect**.
3. You'll need to log on to your FieldView account. Provide your user name and password and click **Log In**.
