Device Management Overview.

In Mobile Device Management (MDM) the device sits at the centre of our universe. Everything is linked to it and revolves around it. This is why the device enrollment process is very important. The extension of this would be who is allowed to use the device, what we allow the device to do, where the device is as well as when it can do it.

To manage your devices using the Edlink MDM platform, you need to enroll the devices into the platform. There are a number of enrollment methods you can choose from and it all depends on your desired level of management, the types of devices and operating systems running on those devices as well as who owns the device. As you can see, there are many permutations to consider when enrolling a device.

Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) lets users enroll their own devices onto a school account, these are also referred to as home-owned devices.

The enrollment options available on the platform are clearly labelled to make the enrollment process as smooth as possible. The Edlink platform currently supports enrollment for iOS, MacOS, Android and Chromebook devices.
