# SAMSUNG



The Knox Mobile Enrollment enables you to enroll multiple Samsung devices in an MDM without having to manually configure each device.

Then, click the **Start** now button. A familiar window will appear, guiding you through the process. After uploading CSV to FAMOC and then back to Samsung KNOX, a device import history table will be displayed from which you can redownload the device list CSV file if needed.

Sign in to Knox Mobile Enrollment Portal with your credentials. Then:

1. Go to Profiles, click Add and connect with an MDM server by pasting an MDM URI below.
