Clay Key chains

Create 5 cool key chains with
super-soft and blendable air dry clay!

Important Information About This Clay

When working with this clay, make sure your hands and work area are super-clean. This clay dries quickly when exposed to air, so be sure to keep your clay covered when not in use. Clay may leave residue on some surfaces. If you need to protect your work surface, use a plastic place mat or a plastic grocery bag. Wash your hands when you are done crafting with clay. Remember, once you open the clay, it will begin to dry out. Keep the clay in the re-sealable bag provided when not in use.

Before You Get Started

- Think about what you'd like to make. Come up with your own clever key chain critters, or use the ideas we have included on the box for inspiration. You can make animals, aliens, alphabet letters or your own crazy creations.
- You can use the clay straight from the package, or mix and match the clay to create new colors. Here is a color mixing chart for you to try.

Blue	+	Yellow	=	Green
Yellow	+	Red	=	Orange
White	+	Blue	=	Light Blue
White	+	Black	=	Gray

Adding white to any color will lighten it.

- Your kit includes plastic key chain connectors. You will need to insert these into your clay before it dries. Once you insert the key chain connector, add a drop of craft glue over the opening. This will help hold it in place. If the clay is too dry, you will not be able to insert the key chain connector.



Fun Techniques To Try

- **Twist**- Roll your clay on a flat surface to create a snake. Repeat using a different color of clay. Place the snakes together and then twist them.
- **Cute Creatures** - Roll a large ball of clay. Roll four smaller balls of clay for legs and add them to the larger one. Make even smaller balls of clay for ears, a nose, or a tail. Glue on wiggle eyes and now you have a new friend.
- Once you are finished crafting set your clay key chain aside to dry. Treat your clay creations with care until they are completely dried. If you need to make a repair, dried clay can be fixed using your craft glue.
- Trade them with your friends or clip them on your backpack, purse, messenger bag –wherever!
