

Here's how the painting technique works - the stones are clear glass, with a rounded top and flat bottom. When you paint on the flat surface the effect is magnified giving a cool optical effect.

## Getting Ready to Paint

Before you start, be sure to wear old clothes and cover your work surface with newspapers to avoid stains.

Try mixing colors to get new ones.

## Instructions

1. You will be using the technique of "reverse glass painting," which means that when you paint on glass and look at it from the other side you see the reverse of what you painted.

2. If you paint a word - you will need to paint it backwards so it can be read correctly from the front side.

3. Make sure paint is completely dry before you adhere the magnet...

4. Applying the magnet back: Cut out a circle from the self-adhesive magnet sheet that is slightly smaller than the glass stone you painted.

Peel the backing from the magnet circle and stick to the painted side of the glass stone.
