

Kid-friendly designs

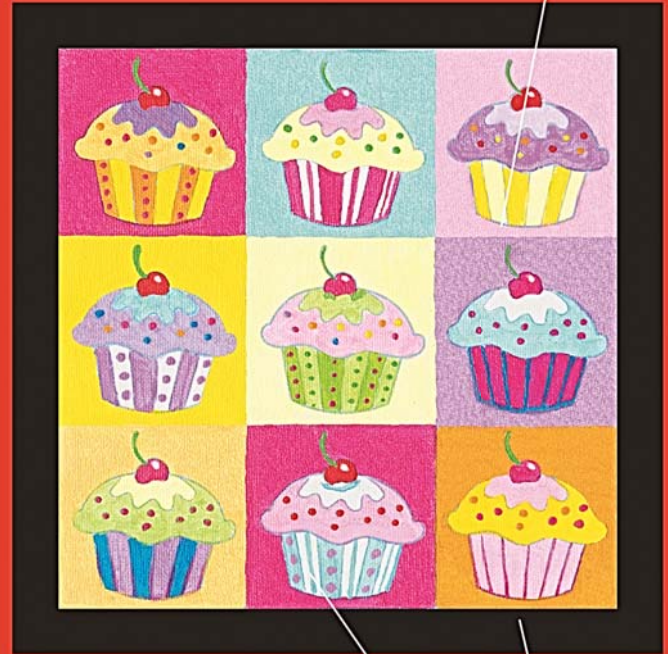
Instructions:

1. Set Up

- a. Cover your work surface with old newspaper or plastic to protect it from paint spills.
- b. Put on a smock or work shirt to protect your clothing from paint.
- c. Fill a container with water for cleaning your brush.
- d. Get a small rag or paper towels for clean-up and a plastic food container lid to use as a palette for mixing colors.

2. Painting by Number

- a. Use the Painting Number Guide to see which paint color should be used in each section.
- b. Begin at the top of the canvas and paint all sections with the same number and then clean your brush before moving on to another color. For tiny spaces, like polka dots and thin lines, it is easiest to color the large areas around these first, wait for them to dry, and then paint in the little spaces.

Color Key

Paint colors 1 through 8 are labeled directly on the paint pots. Colors 9 through 14 are created by mixing two colors together. Mix equal parts using the following combinations:

|  (Color 1) = Hot Pink |  (Color 8) = White |
|  (Color 2) = Red |  (Color 9) = 1 + 8 = Pink |
|  (Color 3) = Orange |  (Color 10) = 6 + 8 = Aqua |
|  (Color 4) = Yellow |  (Color 11) = 4 + 8 = Light Yellow |
|  (Color 5) = Green |  (Color 12) = 5 + 8 = Light Green |
|  (Color 6) = Blue |  (Color 13) = 3 + 8 = Peach |
|  (Color 7) = Purple |  (Color 14) = 7 + 8 = Lavender |

3. Finishing

- a. When all sections are painted, review your work and add any finishing touches.
- b. Allow the paint to dry completely before applying the double-sided tape to the bottom and top of the back side. Center the painting over the Foam Mounting Board and press to attach.
