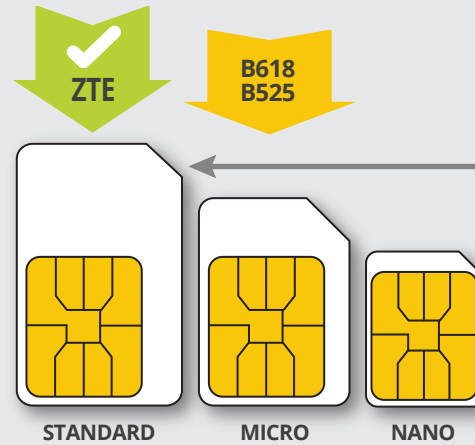
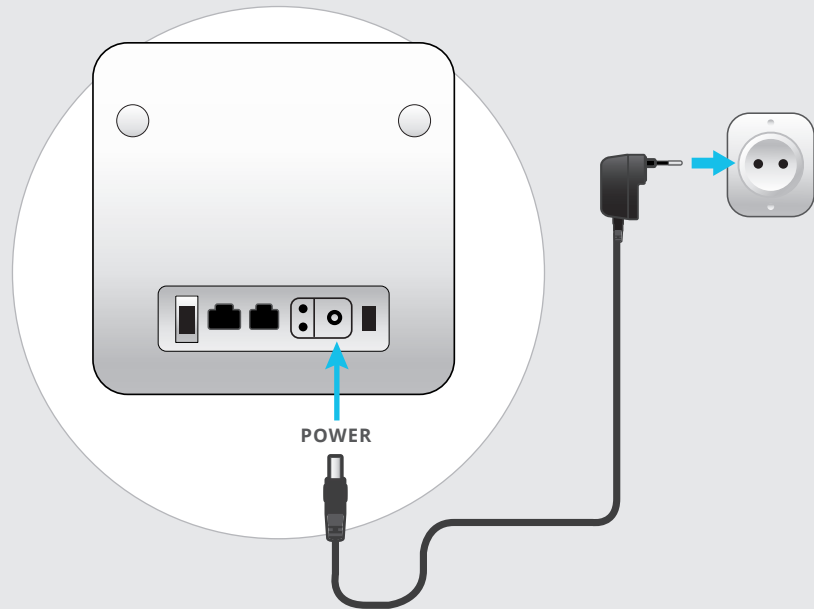
## Quick Start Guide

### WHAT'S IN THE BOX

- 1 LTE Router
- 2 SIM Card
- 3 Power Cable
- 4 Yellow Ethernet "LAN" Cable

### LET'S GET YOU CONNECTED



#### 1 Open your SIM card

- Take your SIM card out of its packaging.
- Pop the SIM out of the card.

#### 3 Plug in your Router

- Connect your power supply to the router and plug it into your wall socket.
- The router's indicator light will turn blue when your router has connected to the internet.
- This can take anywhere from a few minutes to two business days upon first activation

#### What the indicator lights mean:

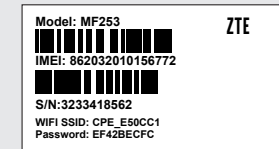
- 3G/4G** **Red Light**  
- Not Connected to Network.
- 3G/4G** **Blue Light**  
- Connected to Network

#### 2 Insert the SIM Into your router

- Insert your Standard SIM into the SIM slot on the left side of your router (push it in until it clicks)

#### 4 Connect to your Wifi

- Turn your Router upside down to find your SSID (Wi-Fi name) and Wi-Fi key (Wi-Fi password).



- Connect your device (laptop works best) using the above username (SSID) and password (Wi-Fi Key).


How to change your Wifi name and password.

### STEP 1

Connect your ZTE router to your PC by either:  
Directly with the yellow LAN cable, or  
By Wifi, using the username and password which you will find on the sticker at the bottom of your router.

### STEP 2

Once connected, open your browser window (Google chrome, Firefox, Internet Explorer, etc.) and type in the following IP address in the URL field: **192.168.0.1**





### STEP 3

In the window that opens, enter the default router username and password:

**Username:** *admin*

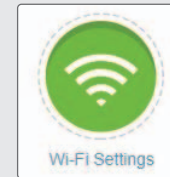
**Password:** *admin*



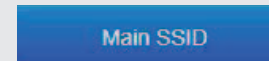

### STEP 4

Click on the "Main SSID" button.




### STEP 5

*Password:* This is where you set your password.
