Investment Impact Fund (IIF)

- ❖ Updated in October with Phase 2
- ❖ Total number of points increased to 666
- ❖ Value of each point remains £200
- ❖ Now includes 3 domains, each broken down by indicators
 - ❖ Prevention and Tackling Health Inequalities Domain – 7 indicators
 - ❖ Providing High Quality Care Domain – 10 indicators
 - ❖ Sustainable NHS – 2 indicators
- ❖ Many of these are not paid based on data extracted from the clinical system, but on data from elsewhere

Prevention and Tackling Health Inequalities Domain		Points
VI-01	The percentage of patients aged 65 or over who received a seasonal influenza vaccination between 1 st Sept and 31 st Mar	40 points (min 80% achievement)
VI-02	The percentage of patients aged 18-64 years and in a clinical at-risk group who received a seasonal influenza vaccination between 1 st Sept and 31 st Mar	88 points (min 57% achievement)
VI-03	The percentage of children aged 2-3 who received a seasonal influenza vaccination between 1 st Sept and 31 st Mar	14 points (min 45% achievement)
HI-01	The percentage of patients on the Learning Disability register aged 14 or over who received an annual Learning Disability Health Check and have a completed Health Action Plan	36 points (min 49% achievement)
HI-02	Percentage of registered patients with a recording of ethnicity	45 points, (min 81% achievement)

Prevention and Tackling Health Inequalities Domain		Points
CVD-01	CVD-01: Percentage of patients aged 18 years or over, not on the QOF Hypertension Register as of 30 September 2021, who have (i) a last recorded blood pressure reading in the two years prior to 1 October 2021 \geq 140/90mmHg, OR; (ii) a blood pressure reading \geq 140/90mmHg on or after 1 October 2021, for whom there is evidence of clinically appropriate follow-up to confirm or exclude a diagnosis of hypertension by 31 March 2022	53 points, 23% achievement
CVD-02	CVD-02: Percentage of registered patients on the QOF Hypertension Register	27 points, lower threshold 0.2% increase

EC-01	Number of patients aged 18 years or over and recorded as living in a care home, as a percentage of care home beds eligible to receive the Network Contract DES Enhanced Health in Care Homes service	18 points
EC-02	Percentage of care home residents aged 18 years or over who had a Personalised Care and Support Plan (PCSP) agreed or reviewed	18 points, min 80% achievement
EC-02	Percentage of permanent care home residents aged 18 years or over who received a Structured Medication Review	18 points, min 80% achievement
EC-04	Mean number of patient contacts as part of weekly care home round on or after 1 October per care home resident aged 18 years or over	13 points, min achievement is 3 patient contacts per care home resident over 6 months
PC-01	Percentage of patients referred to social prescribing	20 points

ACC-01	Confirmation that, by 30 th June 2021, all practices in the PCN have mapped all active appointment slot types to the new set of national appointment categories, and comply with guidance on recording of appointments	27 points
ACC-02	Number of online consultation submissions received by the PCN on or after 1 January per 1000 registered patients	27 points, threshold 65
ACC-03	By 31 March 2022, analyse and discuss the implications of data on Type 1 A&E attendance rates for minor conditions with the local ICS, making a plan to reduce unnecessary attendances and admissions	56 points
ACC-04	Work collaboratively with local community pharmacy colleagues to develop and commence delivery of a plan to increase referrals to the Community Pharmacist Consultation Service, with referral levels increasing by no later than 31 March 2022	56 points
ACC-05	By 31 March 2022, make use of GP Patient Survey results for practices in the PCN to identify patient groups experiencing inequalities in their experience of access to general practice, and develop and implement a plan to improve access for these patient groups	56 points

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A Sustainable NHS		Points
ES-01	ES-01: Metered Dose Inhaler (MDI) prescriptions as a percentage of all non- salbutamol inhaler prescriptions issued to patients aged 12 or over on or after 1 October	27 points, min achievement 53%
ES-02	Mean carbon emissions per salbutamol inhaler prescribed on or after 1 October (kg CO ₂ e)	27 points, min achievement 25.1 kg CO ₂ e

QOF 2021-22 – things to remember

- ❖ The importance of prevalence
 - ❖ Each patient added to the list can increase your income even if you do not achieve the points for that patient
 - ❖ Use Case Finders to help increase prevalence
- ❖ New Vaccs and Imms domain – a lot of money, much of which can be missed due to coding
- ❖ ‘Time sensitive’ indicators – when you miss the opportunity (e.g. cancer care review) it is too late and you cannot achieve the points for that patient
