Auto Apply

Auto Apply is a very simple application to use, you have the option to either turn this function on or off within the freedom software.

Please note, Auto Apply only works for newly listed items, it will not add a template to a listing that has been listed before you turn Auto Apply on. For this, you must use Bulk Revision to add the template to that said listing.

(As you are on the Infinity package, you get this to try out for 12 months).

How to list

There are many ways that you could list your items to eBay and include your brand-new template. It is up to you to choose which one is best and easiest for you. We believe the following options may be helpful:

Straight through Frootion (using our listing tool)

This option will allow you to keep every aspect of listing your item inside the Freedom tool. Every item listed straight from our tool will automatically have a template applied when it goes live. Through eBay and adding your template with Bulk Revision

With this method, you can list your item to eBay in any way you see fit. Such as from another listing tool or eBay itself. (Just make sure everything is in mostly plain text, as broken HTML descriptions at this point could cause issues when applying the template). How to use Bulk Revision

As previously mentioned, Bulk Revision can be used to add and remove templates from your live items, however, it has many more functions available than just that.

You can amend a range of things on your listings in bulk, including the following:

- Sub-title find and replace
- Description find and replace
- Add to description
- Returns policy
- Start Price
- Buy it now Price
- Reserve Price
- Quantity
- Handling Time

- eBay Motors - Motorcycle parts compatibility
