

Neck Tags

Submitting an item with neck tags is simple. All one is required to do is pass a URL to a publicly available image.

Example Order JSON

There is only one modification to the typical Order JSON to be submitted– the addition of an `AddOns` object that contains the

`necktag_image_url`

After you add the `AddOns` object to an `Item` that supports the printing of a necktag, you're done! If you try to add a necktag to a sku that doesn't support necktags, you'll receive an error telling you so.
