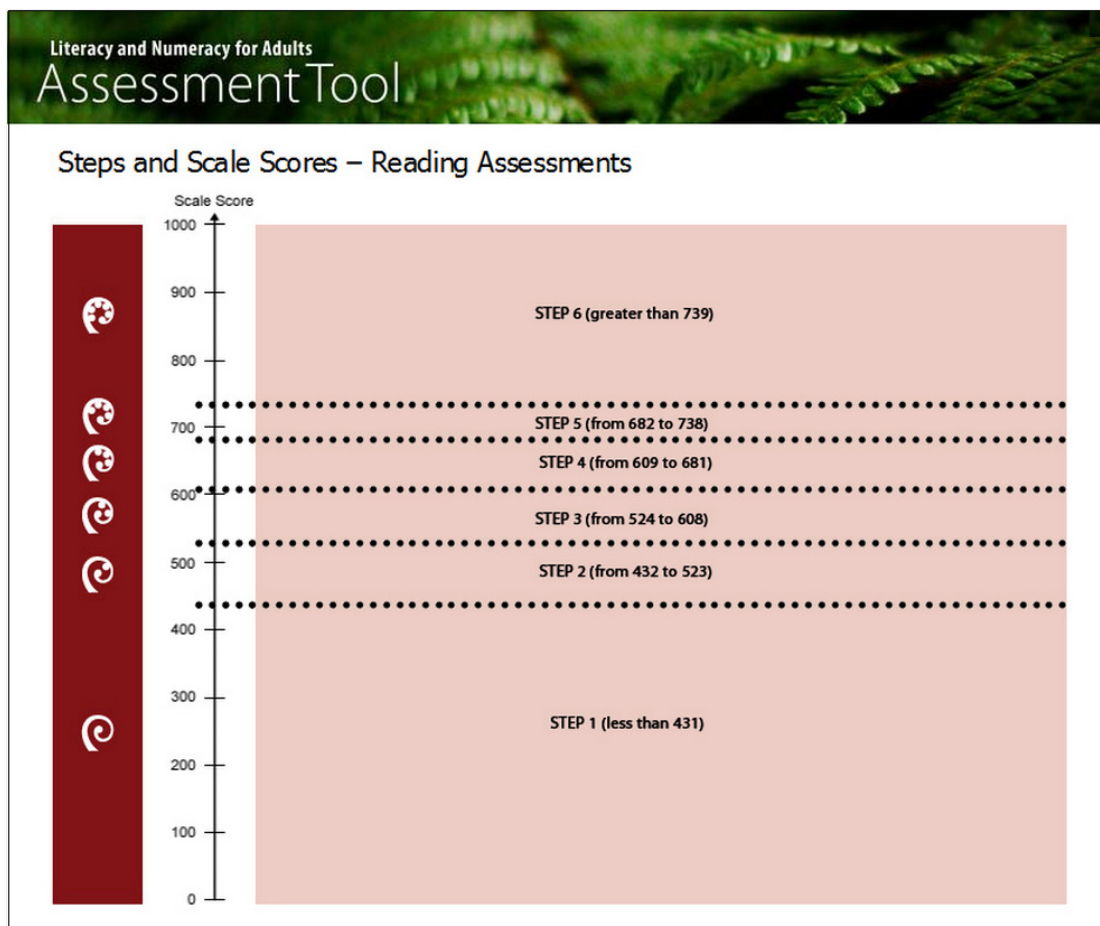


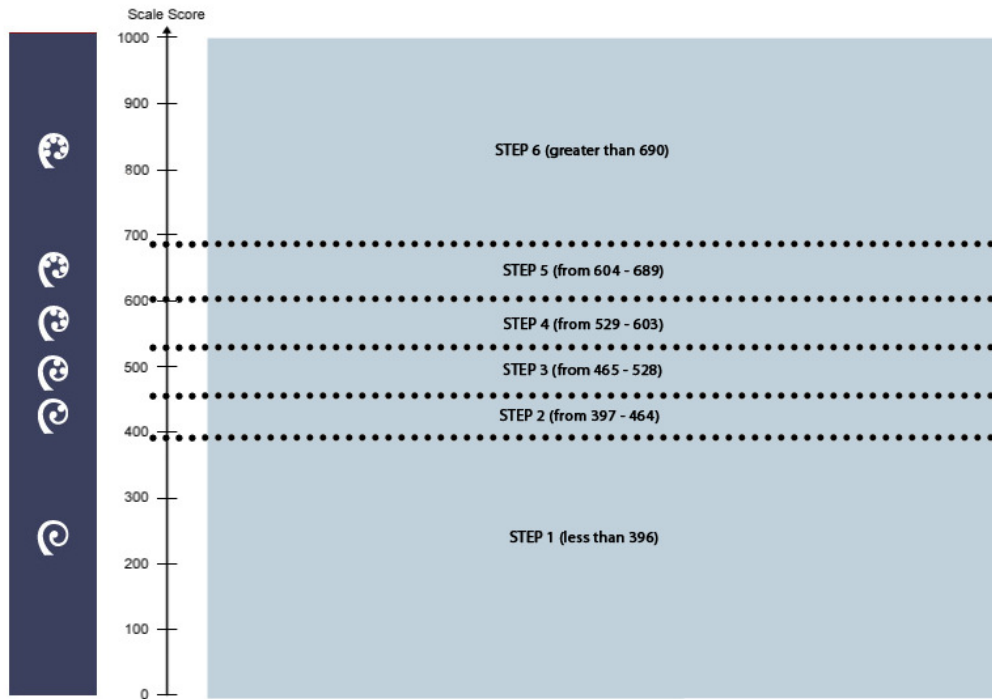
Assessment Tool – Boundary Points of the learning progressions

The following images give a visual representation of how the measurement scale has been mapped onto the learning progressions. In the Assessment Tool the ability estimates are rounded to the nearest whole number. For example, if a boundary point for two steps is 300, all scores less than or equal to 300 are on the step below and all scores 301 to the next boundary point are on the step above.



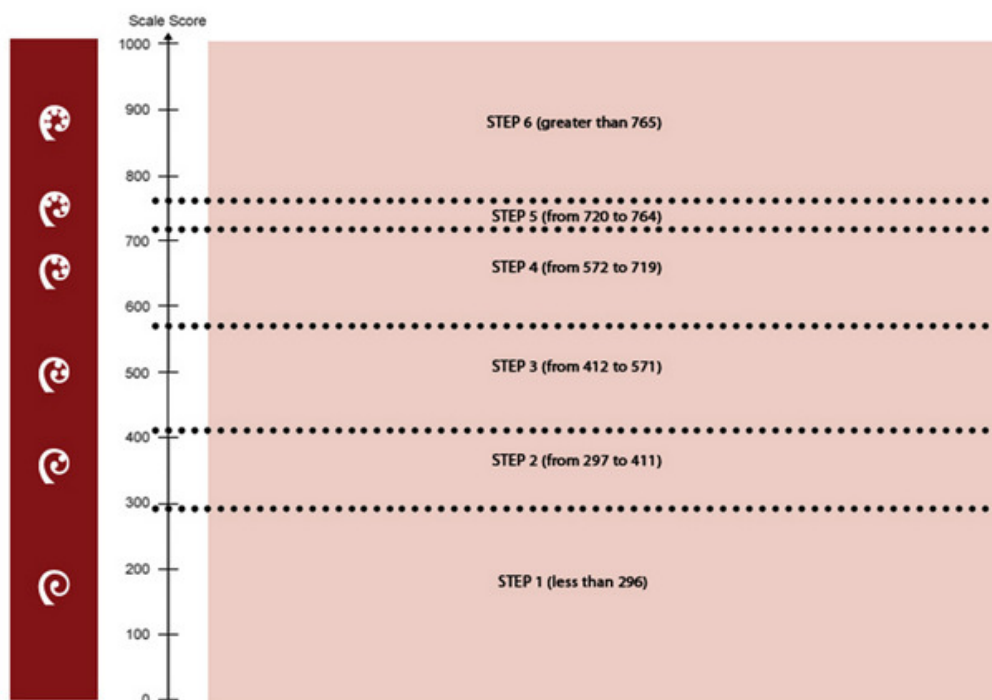

Steps and Scale Scores – Numeracy Assessments

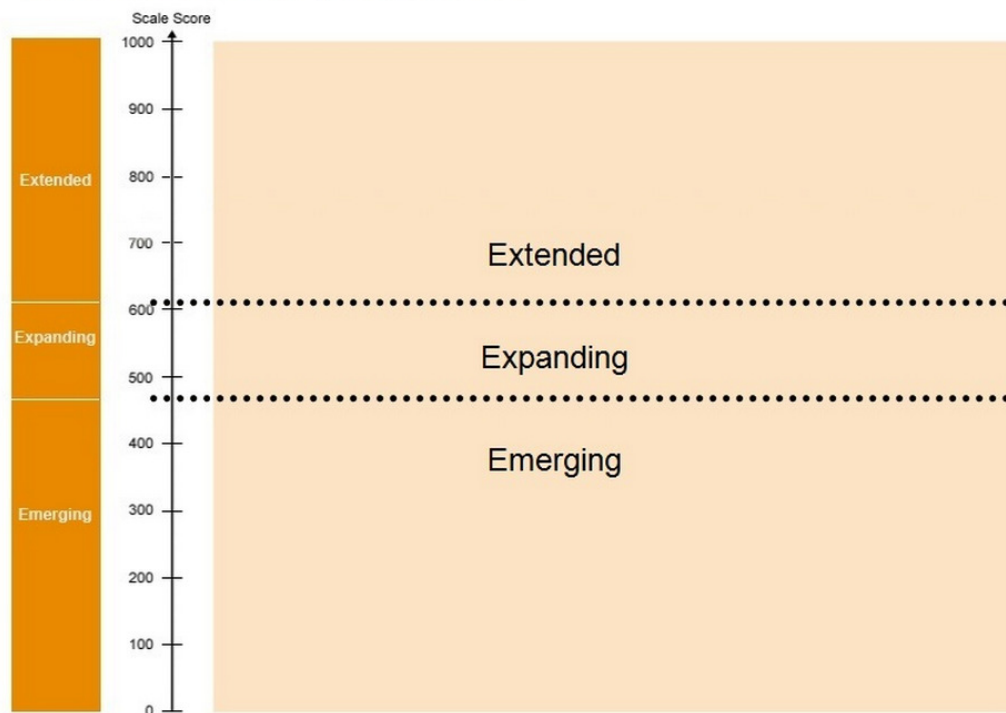
