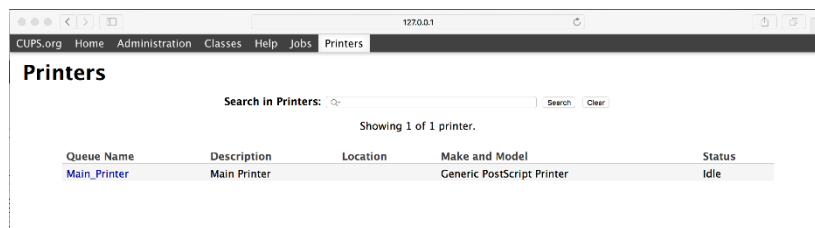


Banner sheet default change for MAC users

1. In a browser go to the webpage 127.0.0.1:631/printers. * Note: If you get an error message such as "cannot connect" or "web interface is disabled": start the Terminal app (in **Applications > Utilities**) and enter the command: `cupsctl WebInterface=Yes`
2. Select your printer (link is in blue).



3. Under Administration, select **Set default options**.

4. Save or "set default options" is at the bottom of the list of options.

5. Go back to terminal and run the command: `cupsctl WebInterface=No` if you wish for that webpage to be disabled, e.g. public machine.
