

CoreView Hybrid Agent: Manage Office 365 and On-Premises Office Users Consistently

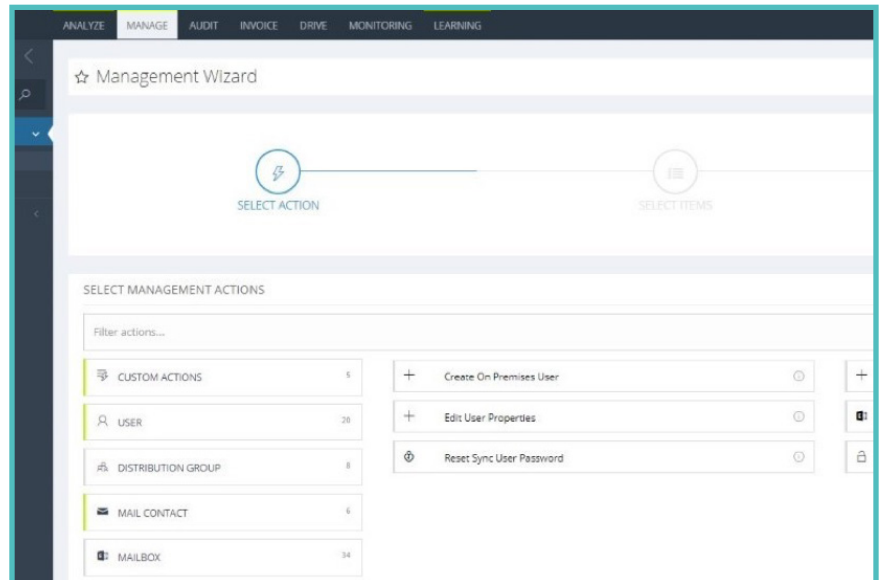
As users are migrated to Office 365 from on-premises Office, managing both environments can be demanding. CoreView can assist during the transition and afterwards, whether that takes weeks or months. CoreView functions in both environments simultaneously using the CoreView Hybrid Agent, so that identities are managed consistently across either environment.

Rather than switching between tools specific to just one environment, CoreView provides a single management interface to update on-premises services, including Active Directory and Exchange servers, alongside managing Office 365. Many functions can be performed from that single management interface, including:

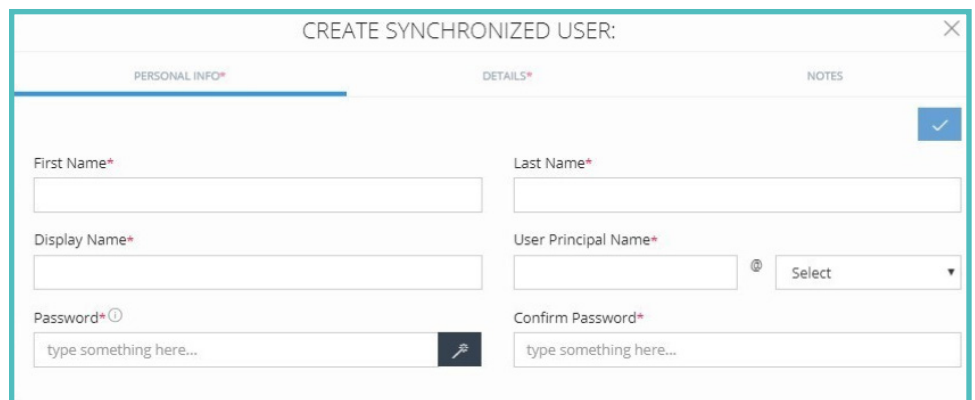
- Wizard-based account creation and password management, easing the effort and reducing errors in setting up accounts, whether for users on O365, on-premises, or synchronized between both.
- User provisioning, deprovisioning, and other updates to user accounts, including adding or removing users from Distribution and Security Groups. This reduces the chance that extraneous login accounts present a security risk.
- Efficient management of users in both environments, including import of OUs (Organization Units), setting OU for any on premise or synchronized user, and creation of virtual tenants.

Easy Synchronized User Creation

CoreView Hybrid Agent includes this wizard shown on the right, to create and edit users synchronized between O365 and on-premises in a single form. This eases user creation and management, since a synchronized user involves the same effort as creating an on-premises user, but utilizes Microsoft Azure AD Connect to create the on cloud object also, as shown below.



Users can be filtered by OU since an import of users from AD can be done. Remote mailboxes can also be enabled or removed.



Avoid Security Risks

Due to CoreView's ability to consistently manage identities across both environments simultaneously, there is reduced risk of inaccurate accounts and orphaned accounts that could present a risk of becoming an attack vector.
