


Logging in with MFA

1. After you enter your username and password you will be prompted with an MFA Challenge.
 - a. Depending on your default sign-in method this could vary.
 - b. In this example the default sign in method is a code from the Microsoft Authenticator app.

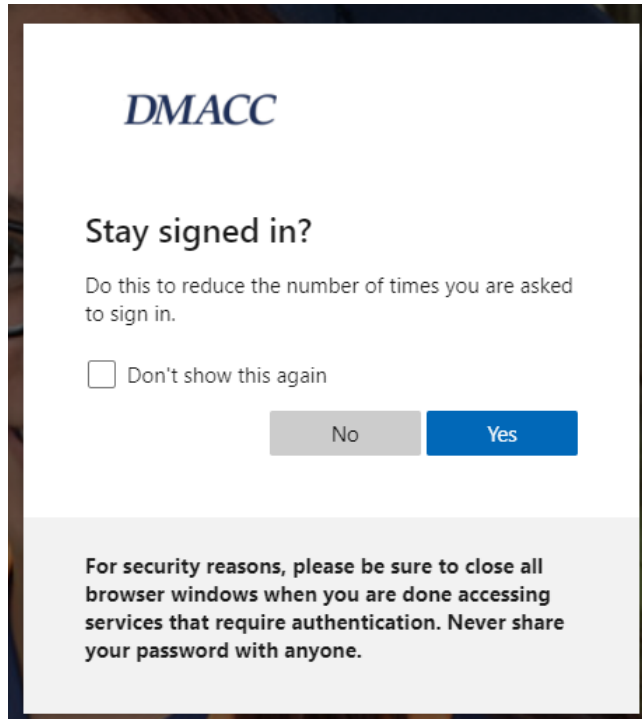

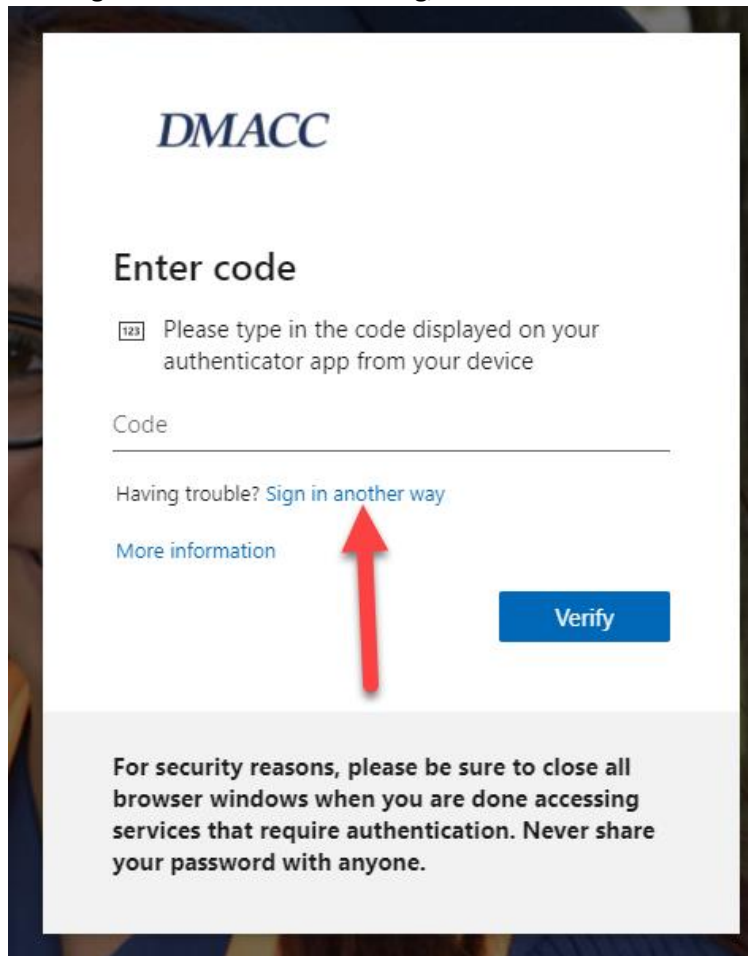
For security reasons, please be sure to close all browser windows when you are done accessing services that require authentication. Never share your password with anyone.

2. Once you enter the code and select “Verify” or hit enter, you will be logged in. It may ask you if you would like to “Stay signed in?” Select what you prefer.
 - a. If you are using a shared or public computer we recommend selecting “No”



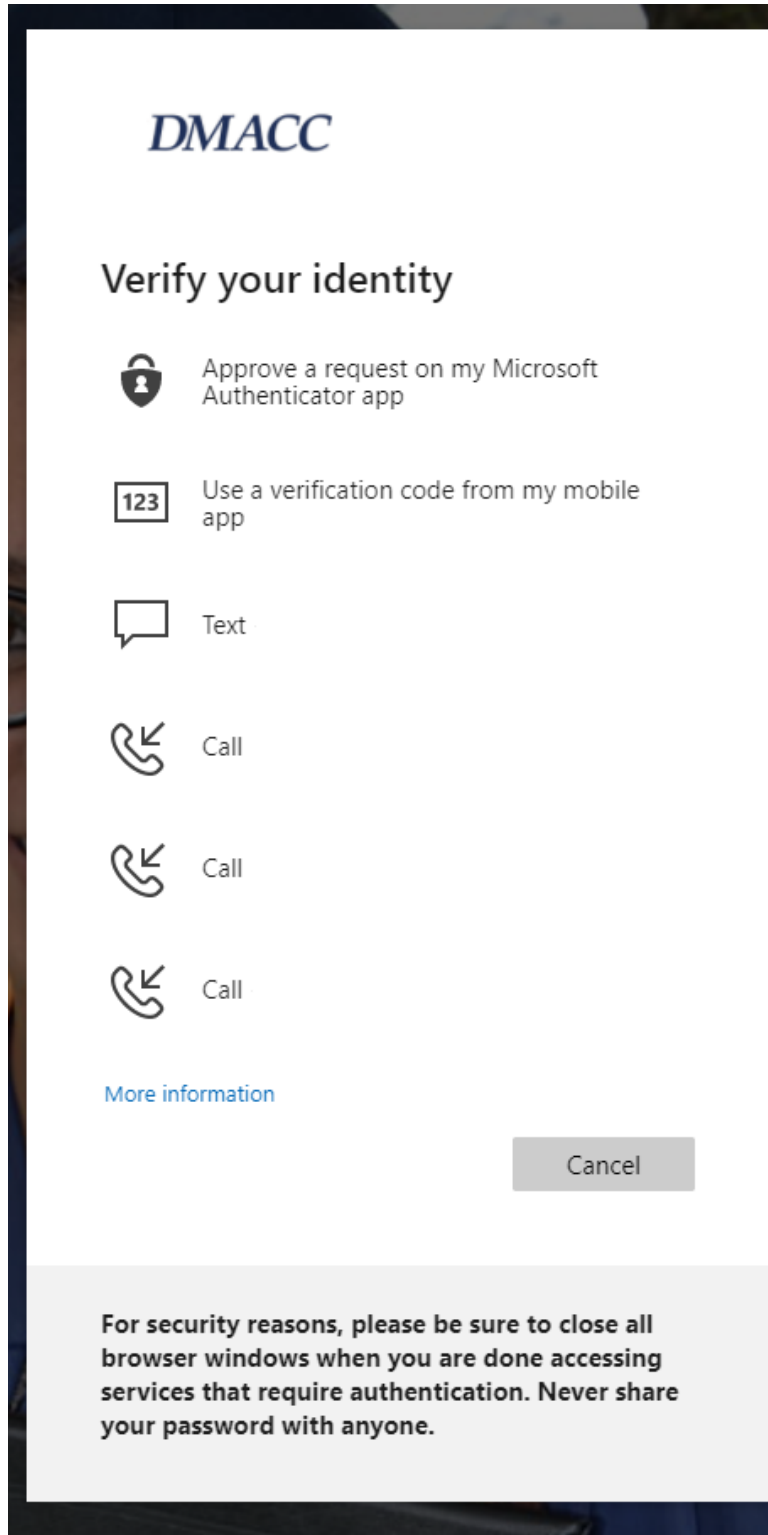
