With Family Playlists you can:


- Know what your child is learning in class.

Proven Impact



A 2019 Impact Study found Family Playlists had a statistically significant impact on students' New York State math test scores. The effect size (Cohen's d) of 0.33 is equivalent to **four months of additional learning**.



The Five Sections of a Family Playlists

- Students complete a **LEARN** activity by watching a video to review the topic.
- Next students complete a **PRACTICE** activity where they engage in the topic on their own.
- After that they **CHECK** their skills by answering multiple choice questions about the topic.
- You and your child will complete the **FAMILY EXPLORATION** activity together and upload your work.
- Finally, you'll submit **FAMILY FEEDBACK**, where you can comment on how the activity went and ask your child's teacher any questions you may have.



How does a Family Playlist work?

Sign Up

Fill out the sign up form given to you by your child's teacher. If you haven't received one, make sure they have your current cell phone number and/or email address.



Receive a Notification

When your child is assigned a Family Playlist, you will receive a text message from (855) 456-7652, or an email that contains a direct link to the assignment. Click the link to get started!

Complete the Family Exploration

Using household materials, your child will lead you through an activity that demonstrates the topic covered in the Family Playlist.



Send Your Teacher Feedback

Let your child's teacher know how the activity went, ask them a question, or leave a comment on how they can further support your child's learning!



Submit your feedback on a computer, a smartphone, a tablet, or even on paper.
