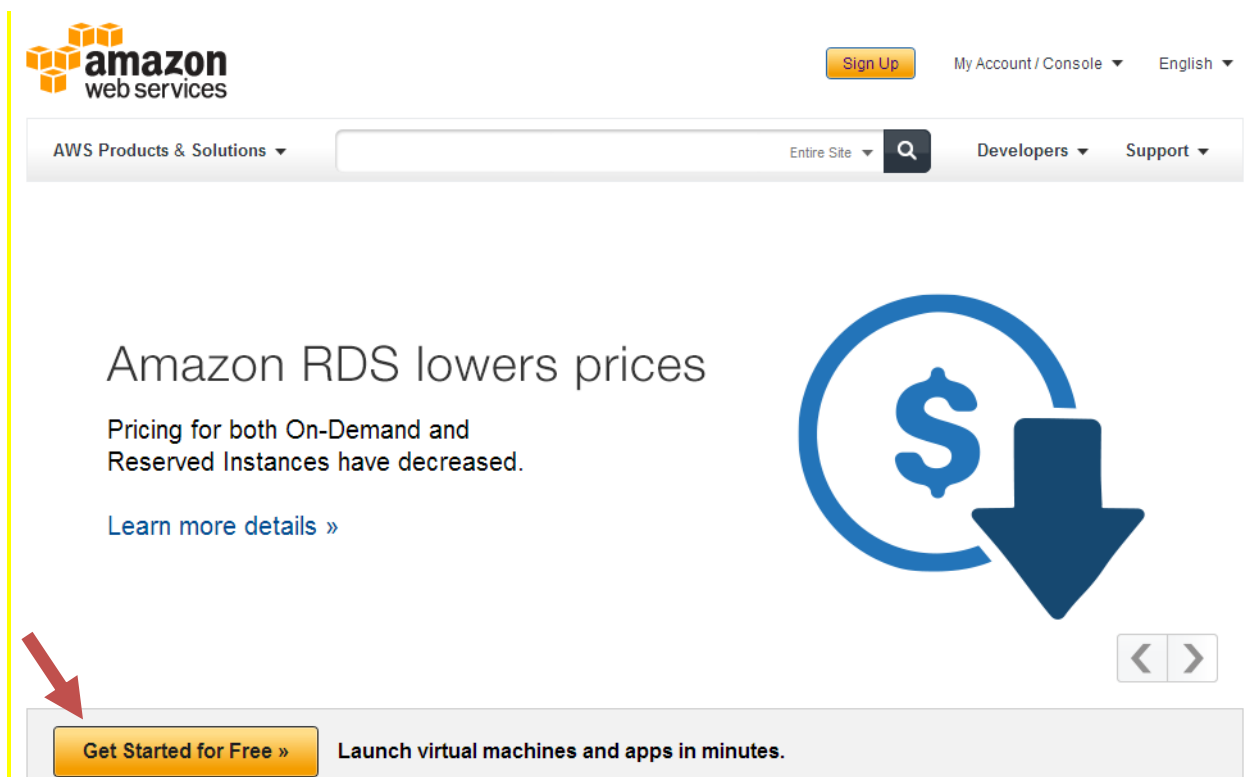


Steps needed to Access free account of AWS

1. Go to aws.amazon.com
2. Click on “Get started for free” button.
