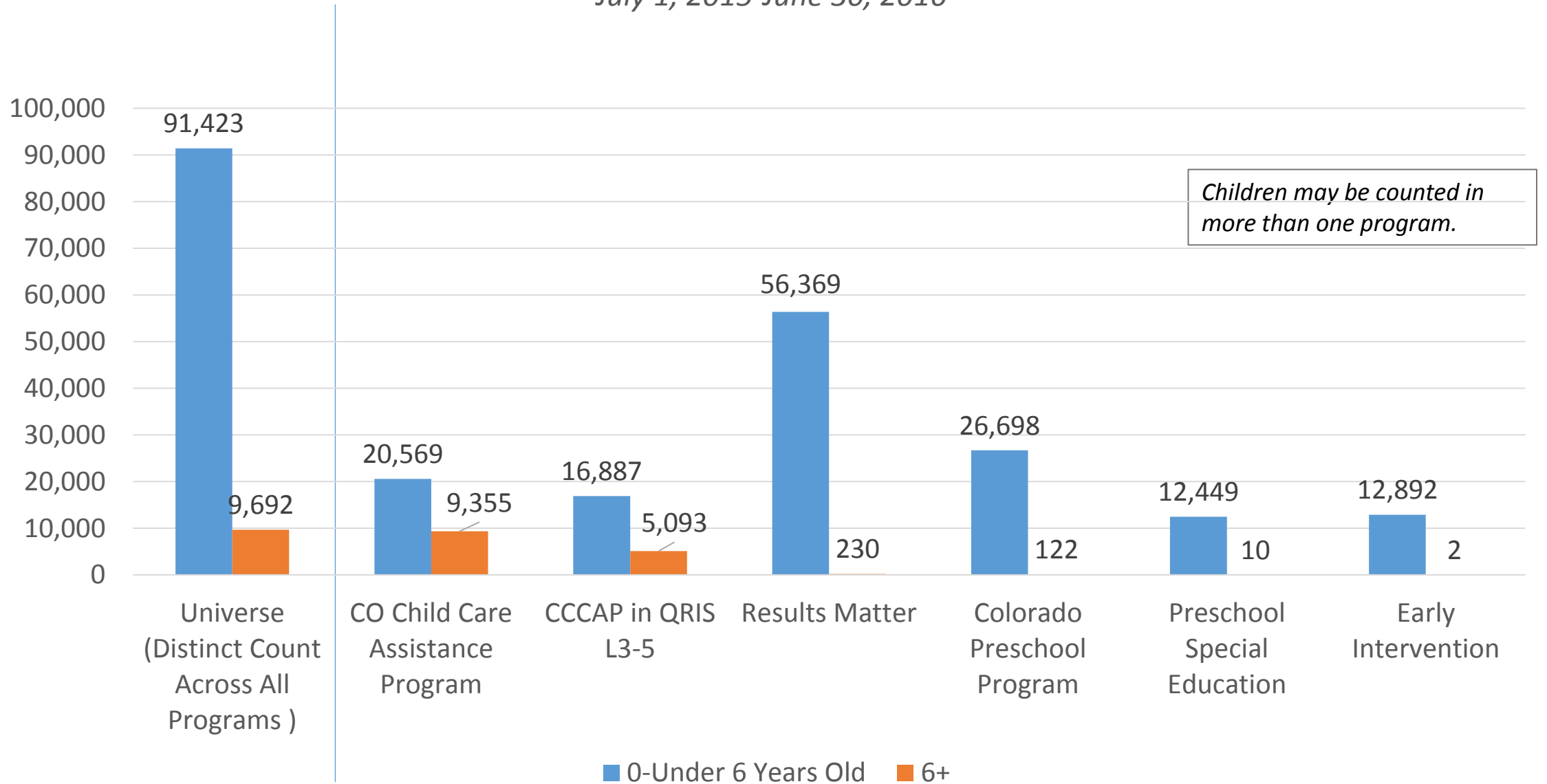

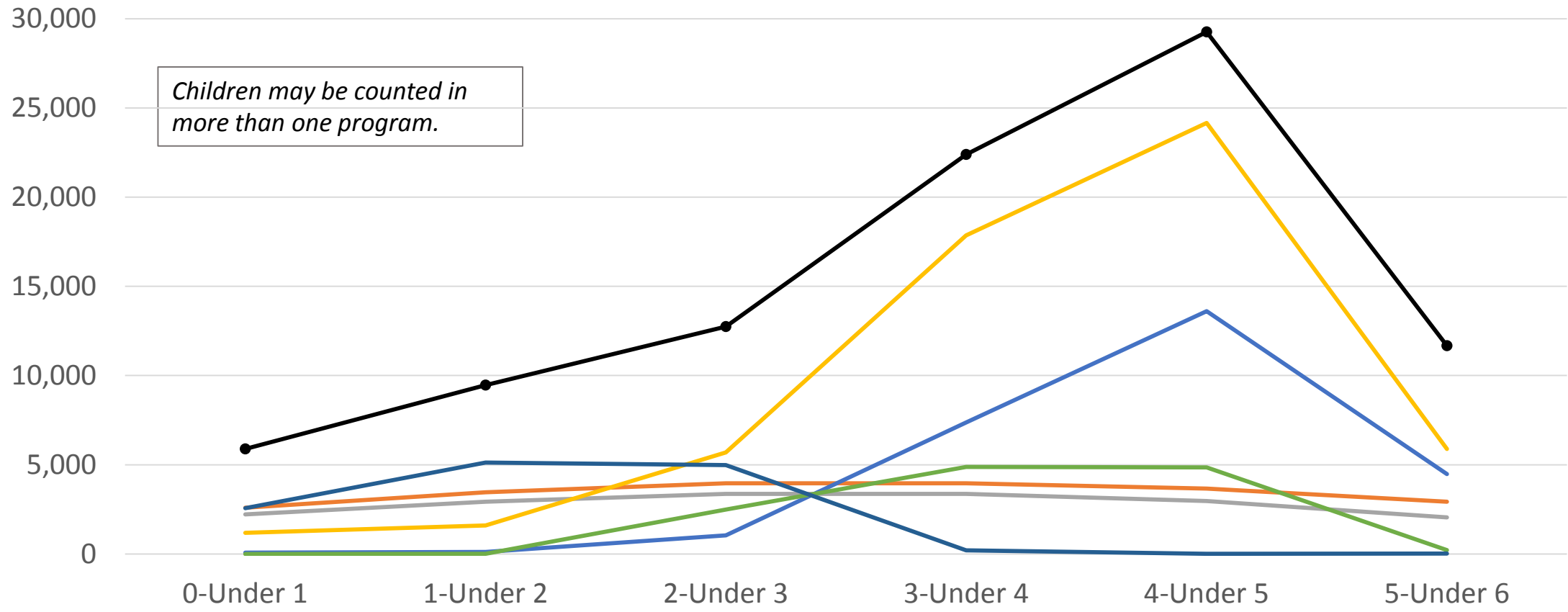
# Count of Participating Children by Program by Age 0-Under 6 and 6+

July 1, 2015-June 30, 2016



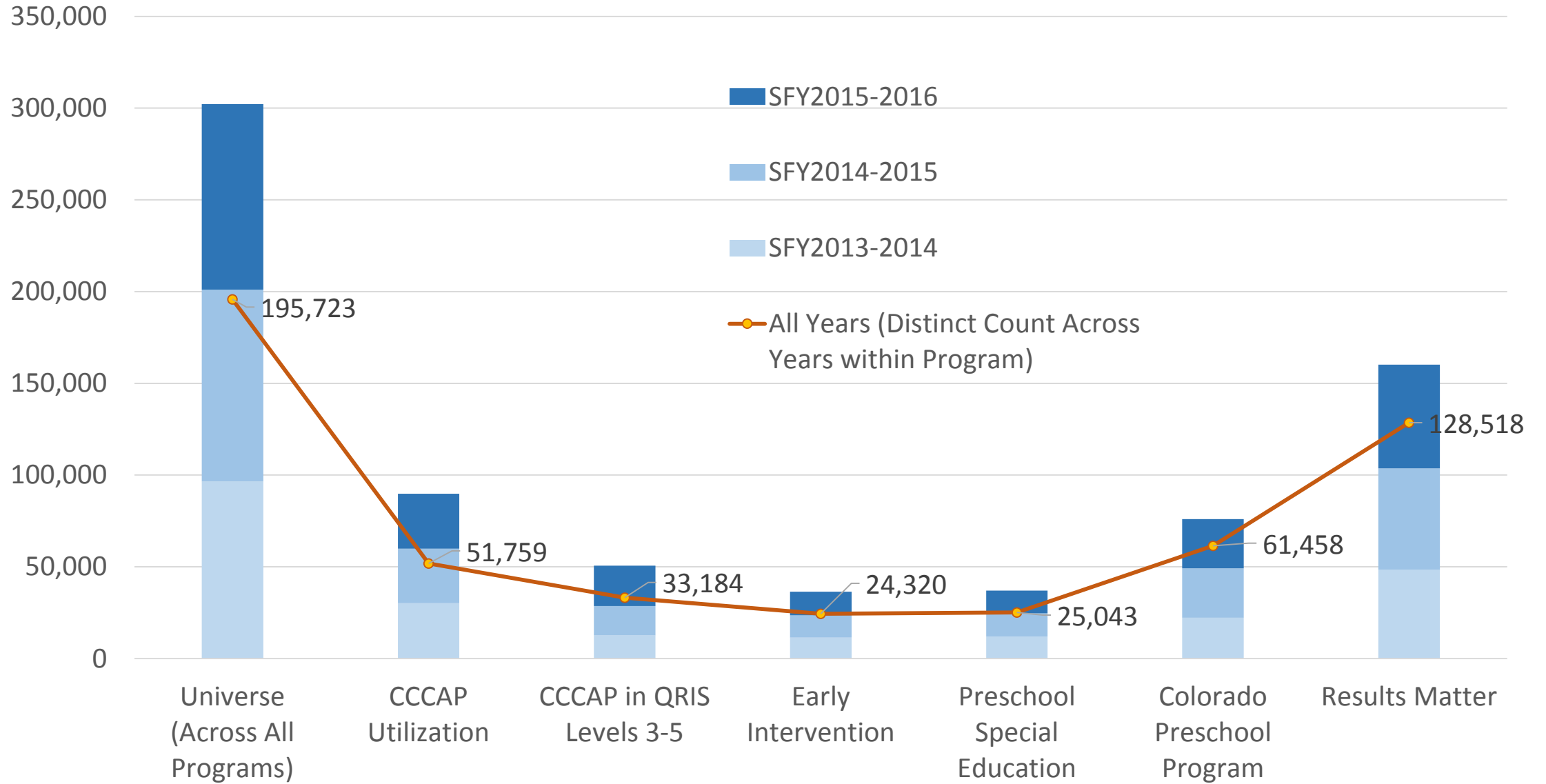
# Count of Participation Children by Program and Age 0 - Under 6

July 1, 2015-June 30, 2016



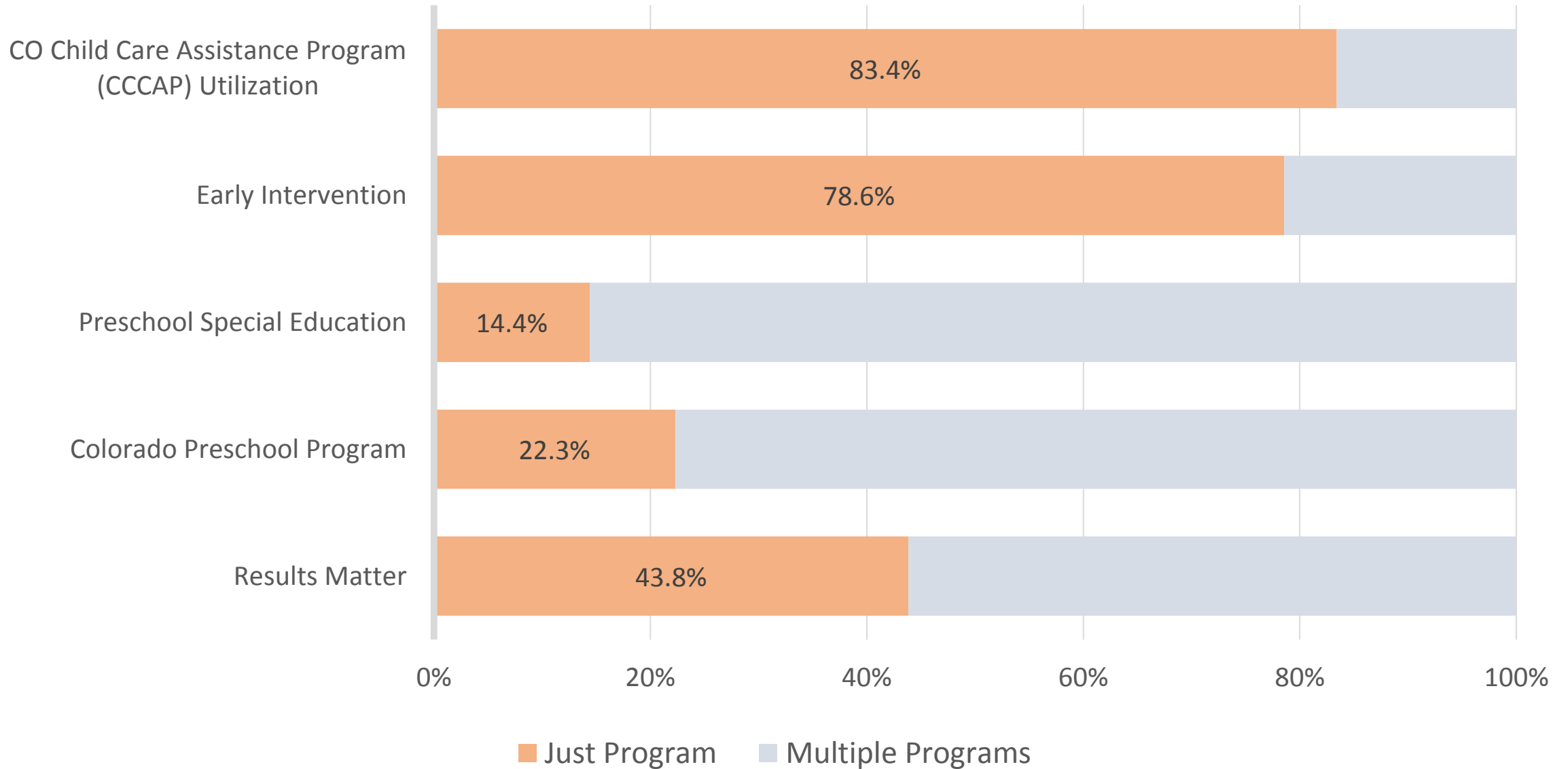

*July 1, 2015-June 30, 2016*



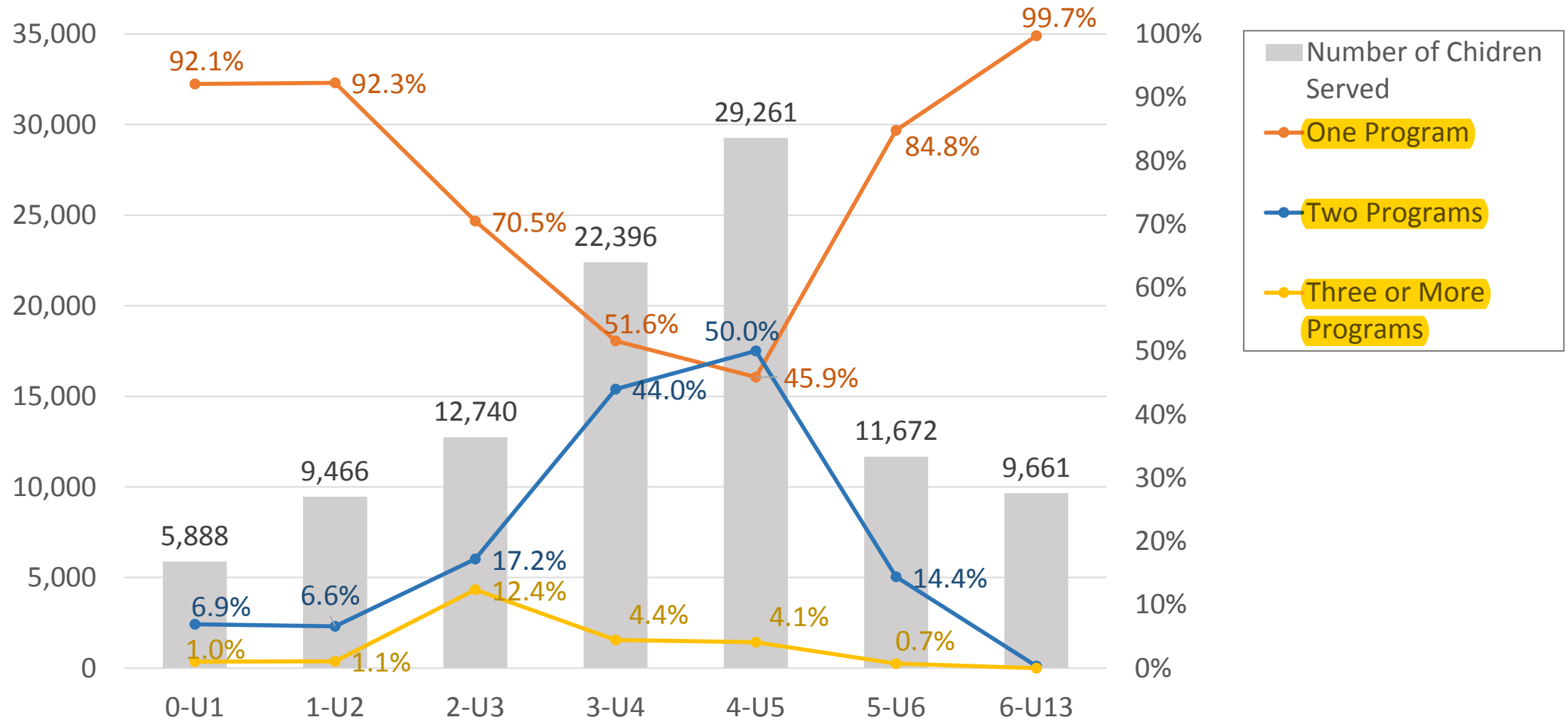

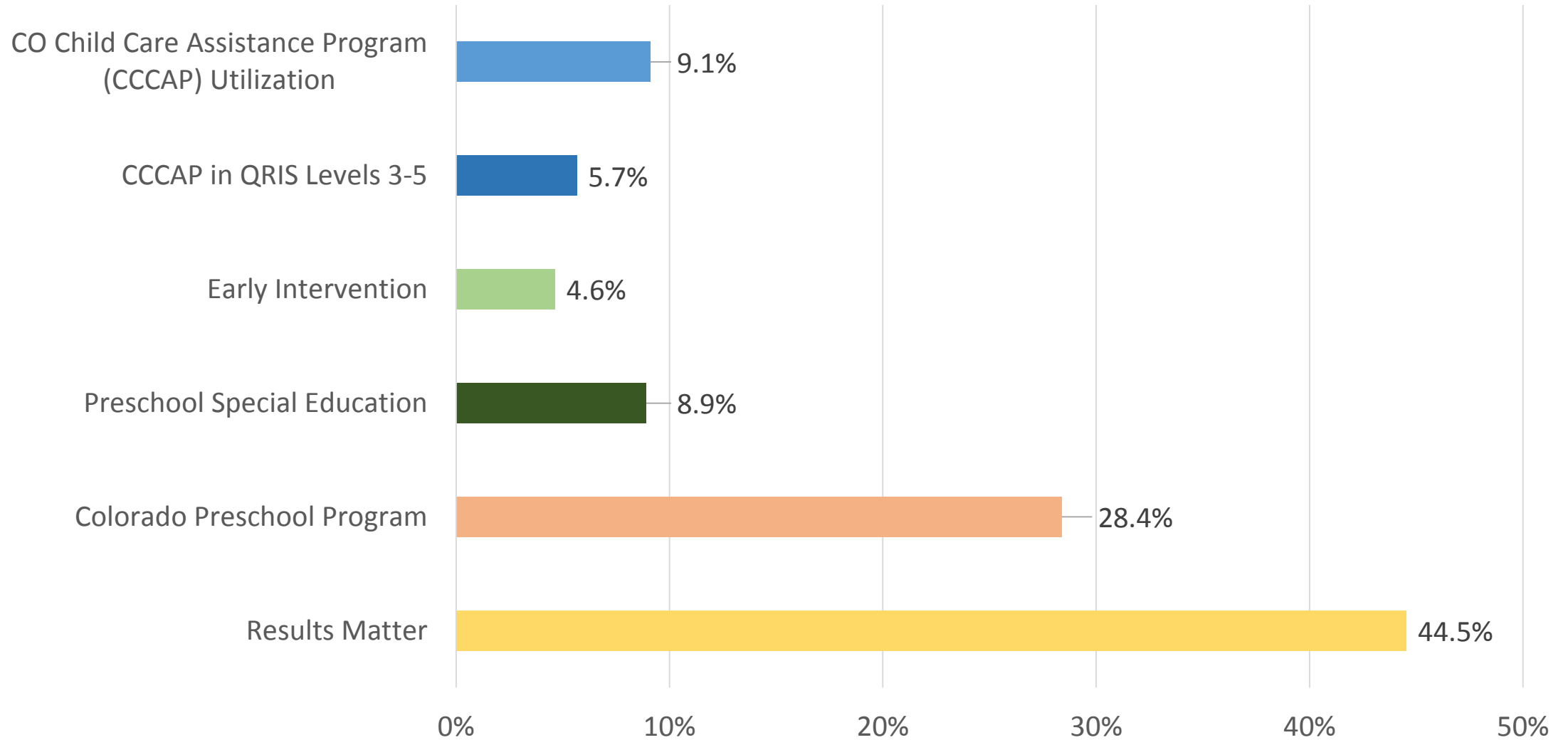

## Head Start Pilot Project and Feasibility Study

- **Head Start identified** in and HB 08-1364 and ECP data sharing agreement
- Head Start is **direct federal-to-local funding**. No existing pipeline to collect/match data at the state level.
- **CDE is partnering with the Colorado Head Start Association** to determine how this sub population can participate in the future
- **Pilot project and feasibility study** completed May 2017:
  - Gathering Head Start data as an additional source will give new visibility into a program that is anticipated to often serve the same children and families
  - Head Start/Early Head Start added to the initial use case
  - State solicited willing Head Start grantees and delegates to participate as a pilot group to match participation records to other ECP programs.
  - Aggregate reports returned to pilot participants illustrating matches with other program participation (CPP, Early Intervention, etc.)
  - Pilot group received feasibility results outlining implementation choices and budgetary considerations
