The floor is free from hazards such as sharp items, food or toxic substances <i>See our blog post for a full overview of toxic substances</i>		The house is able to be well ventilated on hot days and is able to be warm enough for small pets in cold weather	
Electrical cords and curtain cords are not easily accessible to the pets		If there are bars on the windows, the spaces between the bars are small enough so that a pet cannot escape, or the window is kept closed	
All screens that the pet may come in contact with are in a good state and are secure, so the pet is not able to escape		If a window is kept open it is high enough up so that a pet cannot access the windowsill via furniture	
The latches on doors or windows are not able to be opened by a pet		The pet has access to food, water, toys and somewhere to sleep	
Pets cannot access food or hazardous items in cupboards or on kitchen benches		You have done a general walk through your indoor area to check any other means of escape or hazards, not mentioned above
