Resale basics

- People tend to overvalue their items
- Just because it is listed online does not mean it would sell for that price
- We look for items that have a “market demand”
- Large items expected resale value > \$200
- Small items expected resale value > \$50

Furniture

Consignment

- Good or better condition, some wear ok
- In style (modern, mid century, branded, vintage)
- Antiques (though much smaller market)
- Mid (Pottery Barn , Room & Board, Crate & Barrel) and high-end (Stickley, Baker, Henredon, Herman Miller, etc) brands
- High-end bookcases, office furniture, bed frames
- Outdoor

Donation

- Because furniture is difficult to store, donating pieces is usually difficult
- Small pieces (dressers, dining sets) good condition with some wear ok

Recycle

- Older large pieces out of style: Armoires, hutches, china cabinets, entertainment centers
- Dining tables without chairs, bed frames
- Pieces with significant wear, scratches, or missing pieces, stained
- Particle board/laminate
- Out of style sofas
- Cubicles, desks, filing cabinets, and other office
- Mattress and box-springs

Consignment



- Modern style
- No stains/
smell/ wear
- Good brand

Recycle



- Stains, wear, or
smell
- Outdated
pattern/ style

Decor

Consignment

- Quality (Persian, handmade, needlepoint) rugs with minimal wear
- Framed mirrors

Donation

- Standard rugs in good condition with some wear ok
- Small decor items in ok condition with limited value

Recycle

- Broken and damaged pieces
- Commodity mirrors and lamps
- Holiday decor
- Bedding, towels, etc

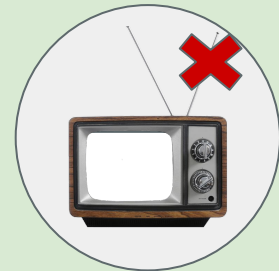


Art

- Collectibles, oil-paintings, watercolor, acrylics, unique prints, and signed pieces have a resale market
- Damaged pieces, posters/ reprints, or inexpensive canvas prints are typically donation or recycle



Electronics



Consign

- Working condition
- Less than 4 years old
- Brands like Mac, Samsung, etc
- Cameras, high-end monitors

Donation

- Working condition
- A bit dated, low-end

Recycle

- Broken/not functioning well
- Missing pieces

Music & Tools

Consign

- Working music equipment & instruments
- Working home tools

Donation

- Working condition
- Dated, low-end

Recycle

- Most pianos
- Non-working items

Clothes and Jewelry

Consignment-

Pieces that are in very good or better condition and are designer or luxury brands (mostly women's)

Donation-

Pieces in good condition but with some wear

Recycle-

Pieces with excessive wear, damaged or stained



Appliances

Consignment

- Working condition
- No missing parts
- Clean/ very good condition
- Small appliances

Donation

- Small appliances
- Working condition
- Value is <\$100 new
- Decent condition

Recycle

- Damaged and dirty
- Pieces missing
- Obvious signs of wear
- Older models

Sports and Outdoors

Consignment

- Outdoor/ gym equipment in good condition
- Less than 5 years old
- Skis, bikes, weights, and stationary gym equipment



Donation/ recycle

- Items with significant wear or use
- Old, broken, or clear signs of overuse
- Older models
