

## Bird Feeder Pole Instructions

### Tools Needed:

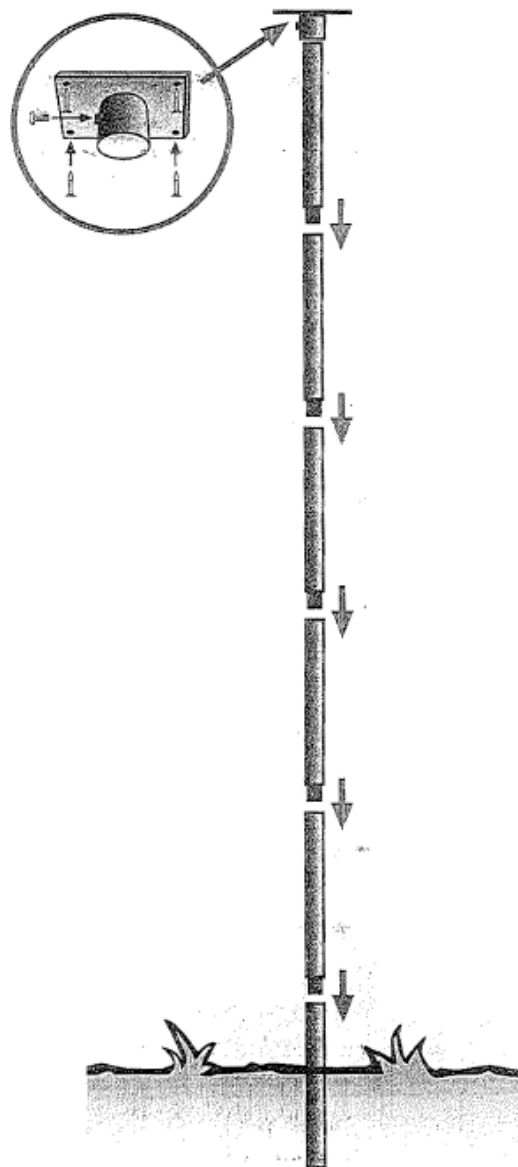
Large Hammer  
Phillips Screwdriver  
Wood Block (soft wood)

### Contents:

Straight Pole Section (1)  
Tapered Pole Sections (5)  
Wood Screws (4)  
Mounting Flange (1)

### Steps:

1. Soak installation site with water, prior to pole installation.
2. Locate straight pole section. With hammer and wood block, drive straight pole section into ground approximately 12 inches, leaving 3 to 4 inches above ground. (Using block of soft wood while driving pole section will eliminate potential damage.)
3. Assemble 5 tapered pole sections. With tapered ends down, insert tapered pole sections into straight pole section.
4. Locate mounting flange against bottom feeder, so that it is centered and flat on surface. With Phillips screwdriver, install 4 wood screws.
5. Insert flange on top of already assembled pole. With Phillips screwdriver, tighten setscrew.
