3. **Extreme poverty**: Poverty keeps billions of people stuck in a miserable hopeless living condition. Half of the world lives on less than 2 dollars a day—that's three billion people. One billion people live on less than 1 dollar a day.

1. **Plant reconciliation churches**: 2 Corinthians 5:20 We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be_____to God.
