

## THE 5 PASSES OF PHRASING: **DIALS**

### 1st: **DIVIDE**

**Divide the passage into phrases.**

When the phrase is in the middle of another phrase you will need to extract it.

For our sake  
he made him to be sin  
who knew no sin,  
so that ... we might become the righteousness  
of God.

### 2nd: **INDENT**

**Indent the subordinate phrases.**

The main phrase is set to the left, and subordinate phrases are indented from the phrase they modify.

### 3rd: **ARROWS**

**Draw arrows to relate the phrases.**

Blue - Genitive phrases.

Green - Relative phrases.

Yellow - All other subordinate phrases.

### 4th: **LABEL**

**Label the relationships between the phrases connected with yellow and blue arrows.**
