HEAVY-DUTY NYLON NETTING

Use Trellis Plus for Perennials

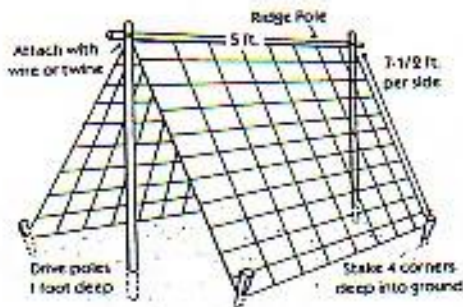
Roses, grapes, clematis and other long-life varieties of flowers can be safely grown undisturbed because Trellis Plus lasts *years* in the field without fast deterioration.

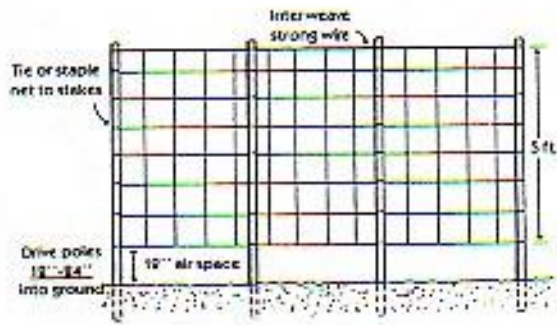
Two Popular Approaches to Trellis Use

A-FRAME TRELLIS



Drive support poles into ground about 1 foot as shown. Attach ridge pole of wood or metal, or stretch wire taut between support poles and extend it to ground (at an angle) at each end and secure with stakes.

STRAIGHT TRELLIS



Drive vertical support poles *deep* into ground, spaced no more than 5 feet apart. Attach net, using twine or staples. Pull net tight! Interweave a wire or pole across top to prevent sagging under weight of bountiful harvest.

Using the “Trellis Trench” Method

Vegetable Trench Jungle. This great idea is perfectly suited for use with the Trellis Plus Vegetable Netting. Dig a 12” deep x 12” wide trench under each side of Trellis: loosen soil in bottom. Spread 4 inches of manure at bottom. Fill in with good garden soil (loose & friable!). Mix in well two cups of 5-10-5 fertilizer and a dusting of lime. Leave 2” impression to catch run-off water. Plant along each side of trellis, training vines up Trellis.

Re-emphasizing Sugar Snap!

Sugar Snap Pea- The super sweet *new* All-American variety pea that’s delicious raw or cooked! Plant close together, not in single rows but 4 abreast! Yield is much greater and you maximize your vertical space.
