All-Natural Fertilizer (4-3-4)

Directions

New Plantings:

- When transplanting, apply at a rate of 1 lb. per 100 square feet. Scratch the food into the soil.

Existing Plantings:

- In the spring when plants begin putting on new growth, broadcast at a rate of 1 lb. per 100 square feet. Scratch the food into the soil.
- When plants finish bearing fruit, typically in late August, follow with a second application at the same rate as the spring application.
- For individual plants, apply 2 Tbsp. per plant twice per season.
