



Raspberry and Blackberry Food

All-Natural Fertilizer (4-2-4)

Directions

New Plantings:

- Before planting new raspberries and other cane fruits, apply ¼ cup per plant in the hole at planting time. Water into the soil thoroughly, and then place the plant in the hole.
- When the new plants flower or set fruit, scratch in an additional ¼ cup per plant.

Existing Plantings:

- Apply at the rate of 5 lbs. per 100 sq. ft. in early spring and again when fruit starts to form. Broadcast evenly under canes, and then scratch into the top 2 in. of soil. Be careful not to disturb the roots. If the roots are shallow, water the fertilizer into the soil thoroughly.
- If fertilizing one individual cane only, follow the newly planted rate of ¼ cup per plant, feeding in early spring and again when fruit is setting.
