

In Search of Renewal: The Spiritual Legacy of Rabbi Zalman Schachter-Shalomi With Rabbi Or Rose

Rabbi Zalman Schachter-Shalomi (1924-2014) was one of the most influential and creative Jewish figures of the last decades. Trained as a Hasidic rabbi in the HaBaD-Lubavitch community, he became a leading figure in the translation and teaching of the Jewish mysticial tradition across the Jewish community and far beyond. Weaving together teachings from Kabbalah and Hasidism with insights from several other religious and wisdom traditions, he created the Jewish Renewal Movement. He played a vital role in interreligious and cross-cultural understanding through his teaching, dialogue, and ritual innovations.
