The contributor's signature designates his or her contribution to the elections described above. Contributions that exceed a donor's contribution limit to a participating Committee shall be reallocated to the remaining Committees according to this allocation formula to the extent permitted by FECA. Any contributor may designate his or her contribution to a specific participant Committee to the extent permitted by FECA. Federal law requires us to use our best efforts to collect and report the name, mailing address, occupation, and name of employer of each individual whose aggregate contributions exceed \$200 in an election cycle or calendar year, as applicable.

Joint Fundraising Notice

Tony Wied Victory Committee ("JFC") is a joint fundraising committee authorized by and composed of Tony Wied for Congress ("Campaign"), Right Wisconsin PAC ("LPAC"), and NRCC (each, a "Committee," and collectively, the "Committees"). Any contribution to the JFC permissible under the Federal ElectionCampaign Act, as amended ("FECA"), from contributors who have not exceeded their applicable Federal contribution limits, shall be allocated among the Committees pursuant to FECA and the formula set forth in this Notice.

Contributions Made by an Individual or Federal Non-Multicandidate Political Committee:

Individuals or federal non-multicandidate PACs may contribute up to \$307,300 annually. Such contributions shall be allocated in the following order:

- 1. Campaign shall receive any contribution not exceeding \$6,600, designating up to \$3,300 to the 2024 special general election and up to \$3,300 to the 2024 regular general election, provided such limits apply.
- 2.LPAC shall receive any contribution not exceeding \$5,000 annually.
- 3. Campaign shall receive any contribution not exceeding \$6,600, designating up to \$3,300 to the 2024 regular primary election debt retirement (to the extent lawful debts from that election remain outstanding), and up to \$3,300 to the 2024 special primary election debt retirement (to the extent lawful debts from that election remain outstanding).
- 4.NRCC shall receive for its General Account any contribution not exceeding \$41,300 annually.
- 5.NRCC shall receive for its Building Fund any contribution not exceeding \$123,900 annually.
- 6.NRCC shall receive for its Legal Proceedings Fund any contribution not exceeding \$123,900 annually.

Contributions Made by a Federal Multicandidate Political Committee:

Multicandidate PACs may contribute up to \$130,000 annually. Such contributions shall be allocated in the following order:

- 1. Campaign shall receive any contribution not exceeding \$10,000, designating up to \$5,000 to the 2024 special general election and up to \$5,000 to the 2024 regular general election, provided such limits apply.
- 2.LPAC shall receive any contribution not exceeding \$5,000 annually.
- 3. Campaign shall receive any contribution not exceeding \$10,000, designating up to \$5,000 to the 2024 regular primary election debt retirement (to the extent lawful debts from that election remain outstanding), and up to \$5,000 to the 2024 special primary election debt retirement (to the extent lawful debts from that election remain outstanding).
- 4.NRCC shall receive for its General Account any contribution not exceeding \$15,000 annually.
- 5. NRCC shall receive for its Building Fund any contribution not exceeding \$45,000 annually.
- 6.NRCC shall receive for its Legal Proceedings Fund any contribution not exceeding \$45,000 annually.

Any contributor may designate his or her contribution to a specific participant Committee to the extent permitted by FECA. Contributions allocated to the Campaign and designated to the repayment of outstanding lawful debts incurred in relation to previous elections shall be reallocated if the Campaign receives sufficient contributions to pay such debts. Federal law requires us to use our best efforts to collect and report the name, mailing address, occupation, and name of employer of each individual whose aggregate contributions exceed \$200 in an election cycle or calendar year, as applicable.
