ORDER

This matter is before the Court on Plaintiffs’ Motion to File Under Seal Exhibits to Plaintiffs’ Status Report [Dkt. No. 113] (“Motion”). Plaintiffs seek to seal Plaintiff’s Exhibits A and B to their Status Report [Dkt. No. 112]. This matter can be resolved without oral argument, as such argument would not aid the decisional process. Upon consideration of the Motion and Rule 5 of this Court’s Local Civil Rules, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Motion is **GRANTED in part and DENIED in part**. Exhibit A shall be sealed because Exhibit A contains financial and personally identifiable information of several individuals, the disclosure of which would cause harm to the Plaintiffs and third parties. Opposingly, Exhibit B shall not be sealed because it contains no confidential or sensitive information that is subject to sealing. It is further

ORDERED that the Clerk’s office shall place the unsealed version of Exhibit B of Plaintiffs’ Status Report [Dkt. No. 112] on the public docket.
