ORDER

Upon consideration of the Motion For Approval Of Second Supplemental Class Notice Plan, and for good cause shown, it is hereby ORDERED that the motion is GRANTED.

It is further ORDERED that, on or before February 20, 2026, Plaintiffs shall cause the approved notice to be sent by first class U.S. Mail to each of the newly identified class members at the addresses provided by Defendants.

It is further ORDERED that, to be timely and effective, all requests for exclusion from the class for the newly identified class members must be postmarked on or before April 6, 2026.

It is further ORDERED that on or before April 27, 2026, Class Counsel shall file a report certifying that notice was provided in accordance with this Order and providing a list of the names of any individuals who timely excluded themselves from the class.

It is further ORDERED that the hearing scheduled for March 13, 2026 will proceed as planned but the Court will hold in abeyance the entry of final judgment until after the new opt-out period has expired.
