JOINT MOTION FOR BRIEFING SCHEDULE

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 6, the parties, by and through undersigned counsel, hereby respectfully move this Court for a briefing schedule to file their respective briefs regarding Plaintiff’s motion for attorney fees (Dkt. 184). Good cause for this relief is as follows.

1. In this case, Plaintiff alleged, on behalf of his dependent children and a class that was later certified by this Court, that the Social Security Administration (“SSA”) has miscalculated the amount of benefits to which children of certain retirees are entitled, in violation of the Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. § 403, and its implementing regulation, 20 C.F.R. § 404.403. *See generally* Compl.

2. On April 27, 2026, the Court granted Plaintiff’s motion for judgment (Dkt. 137) in part and directed that Plaintiff file any motion for attorney fees within 14 days of the Order. Order (Dkt. 176).

3. On May 11, 2026, Plaintiff filed his motion for attorney fees (Dkt. 184). He noticed a hearing on the motion for July 10, 2026. (Dkt. 186).

4. Under the Local Rules, Defendants' response to Plaintiff's motion is due May 26, 2026, and Plaintiff's reply in support of his motion is due June 1, 2026.

5. The parties propose the following briefing schedule:

- a. Defendants file their response to Plaintiff's motion on or before June 2, 2026;
- b. Plaintiff files his reply in support of his motion on or before June 15, 2026.

6. The hearing on the motion for fees is July 10, 2026, so there is no prejudice to either party in extending the deadlines, and the motion will be fully briefed before the hearing.

7. A proposed order is enclosed for the convenience of the Court.
