ORDER

This matter comes before the Court on Plaintiffs' Motion for Clarification. ECF 182. Plaintiffs' Motion asks this Court to amend its Final Judgment Order by further defining which class members' have timely claims that may entitle them to benefits. Upon consideration of Plaintiffs' Motion, it is hereby

ORDERED that Plaintiffs' Motion for Clarification is GRANTED IN PART and DENIED IN PART; it is further

ORDERED that paragraph six of the Final Judgment Order (ECF 176) shall be amended to state the following:

"6. This Final Judgment applies to L.N.P. and his children P.D.P. and L.D.P. and all other members of the class, as defined in the Court's Class Certification Order (ECF 72), who, during the class period beginning May 10, 2024, received a notice of an initial determination regarding their benefit amount (excluding a cost-of-living-adjustment notice), and to whom notice was sent, excluding those who timely requested exclusion from the class as set forth in the exclusion reports filed by Class Counsel."

It is SO ORDERED.
