ORDER

FOR REASONS stated from the bench and in accord with specific rulings and instructions thereto, it is hereby

ORDERED that Plaintiff's Motion to Compel Relevant Discovery [Dkt. No. 84] is **GRANTED in part and DENIED in part**. It is further

ORDERED that Plaintiff's request as to the original list of approximately 40,000 potential class members from which Defendants compiled the class list is **DENIED**. It is further

ORDERED that Defendant shall produce a random sampling of at least one-hundred (100) Notices of Award and updated letters communicating award amounts for the class members no later than September 10, 2025, or alternatively, the parties may resolve this matter via joint stipulation. It is further

ORDERED that Defendant shall produce at least ten (10) of these randomly sampled Notices of Award no later than September 2, 2025.
