ORDER

This matter comes before the Court on Plaintiffs' Motion for Attorneys' Fees. ECF 184. Upon consideration of the Motion and the arguments of counsel, and for the reasons stated in open court, it is hereby

ORDERED that Plaintiffs' Motion for Attorneys' Fees (ECF 184) is GRANTED IN PART and DENIED IN PART; it is further

ORDERED that, pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 406(b), Plaintiffs' counsel shall receive twenty percent of the past-due benefits awarded to class members as defined by the Court's Amended Final Judgment Order, *see* ECF 192, as reasonable compensation for counsel's successful prosecution of this case. Compensation shall be limited to twenty percent of the past-due benefits awarded to class members; Plaintiffs' counsel are not entitled to fees based on past-due benefits received by any auxiliary beneficiaries.

It is SO ORDERED.
