

Business Litigation Treatise Edited by Partner Robert L. Haig Critically Acclaimed in 113 Published Book Reviews

The Second Edition of *Business and Commercial Litigation in Federal Courts*, of which partner Robert L. Haig is Editor-in-Chief, was reviewed in the January/February 2009 issue of *Bar Brief*, the Newsletter of the Beverly Hills Bar Association. The eight volume, 9,000 page treatise, published by the American Bar Association Litigation Section and Thomson West, features 96 chapters written by 199 principal authors, including 18 federal judges. The review concludes that the Second Edition "is a valuable resource for all lawyers who practice in the federal courts."

This treatise has been widely recognized as the definitive reference work in this area of law. The Second Edition of the treatise has received a particularly enthusiastic reception from the legal press, reflected in the *Bar Brief* review and in the 112 other favorable book reviews which have previously been published in legal newspapers and bar journals throughout the United States.
